### Definitions of "Partake" as a verb

### Synonyms of "Partake" as a verb (30 Words)

**be characterized by**      To remain unmolested, undisturbed, or uninterrupted — used only in infinitive form.

<b>consume</b>	Serve oneself to or consume regularly. <i>Accounting provides measures of the economic goods and services <b>consumed</b>.</i>
<b>contribute to</b>	Contribute to some cause.
<b><u>devour</u></b>	Destroy completely. <i>The hungry flames <b>devoured</b> the old house.</i>
<b>drink</b>	Drink excessive amounts of alcohol be an alcoholic. <i>The children like to <b>drink</b> soda.</i>
<b>eat</b>	Eat a meal take a meal. <i>He was <b>eating</b> a hot dog.</i>
<b>engage in</b>	Keep engaged.
<b>enter into</b>	Be or play a part of or in.
<b>evince</b>	Reveal the presence of (a quality or feeling); indicate. <i>The news stories <b>evinced</b> the usual mixture of sympathy and satisfaction.</i>
<b><u>evoke</u></b>	Evoke or provoke to appear or occur. <i><b>Evoke</b> sympathy.</i>
<b>get involved in</b>	Cause to do; cause to act in a specified manner.
<b>have</b>	Have ownership or possession of. <i>Are you going to <b>have</b> a party.</i>
<b>have a hand in</b>	Have or possess, either in a concrete or an abstract sense.
<b>have something to do with</b>	Go through (mental or physical states or experiences).
<b>have the attributes of</b>	Be confronted with.
<b>have the qualities of</b>	Get something; come into possession of.
<b>hint at</b>	Drop a hint; intimate by a hint.
<b><u>ingest</u></b>	Absorb (information). <i>He spent his days <b>ingesting</b> the contents of the library.</i>
<b>join in</b>	Be or become joined or united or linked.
<b><u>manifest</u></b>	Record in a ship's manifest. <i>Each passenger must be <b>manifested</b>.</i>
<b>partake in</b>	Have, give, or receive a share of.
<b>participate in</b>	Become a participant; be involved in.
<b>play a part in</b>	Discharge or direct or be discharged or directed as if in a continuous stream.
<b>polish off</b>	Make (a surface) shine.

<b>share</b>	Have give or receive a share of. <i>The two countries <b>share</b> a long border.</i>
<b>share in</b>	Communicate.
<b>suggest</b>	Suggest the necessity of an intervention in medicine. <i>Ruth <b>suggested</b> a holiday.</i>
<b>take</b>	Make undertake or perform an action or task. <i>She always <b>takes</b> an umbrella.</i>
<b>take part in</b>	Receive willingly something given or offered.
<b>touch</b>	Used to indicate that something is avoided or rejected. <i>He could not <b>touch</b> the meaning of the poem.</i>

## Usage Examples of "Partake" as a verb

- *Visitors can partake in golfing or clay pigeon shooting.*
- *The birth of twins became an event which partook of the mythic.*
- *He partook of a well-earned drink.*

## Associations of "Partake" (30 Words)

<b>bake</b>	A social gathering at which baked food of a specified kind is eaten. <i><b>Bake</b> the potatoes.</i>
<b>baked</b>	Intoxicated by drink or drugs, especially cannabis. <i>Land lying <b>baked</b> in the heat.</i>
<b>bakery</b>	A place where bread and cakes are made or sold. <i><b>Bakery</b> items.</i>
<b>bread</b>	Cover with bread crumbs. <i>I hate doing this but I need the <b>bread</b>.</i>
<b>cake</b>	(of a thick or sticky substance) dry or harden into a solid mass. <i>A starter of goat s cheese and potato <b>cakes</b>.</i>
<b>chef</b>	Work as a chef. <i>He <b>cheffed</b> on a yacht in the Riviera for two years.</i>
<b>cookery</b>	The act of preparing something (as food) by the application of heat. <i><b>Cookery</b> writers.</i>
<b>cookie</b>	A packet of data sent by a web server to a browser, which is returned by the browser each time it subsequently accesses the same server, used to identify the user or track their access to the server. <i>She s a tough <b>cookie</b>.</i>

<b>crispy</b>	Tender and brittle. <i><b>Crispy</b> fried bacon.</i>
<b>crumb</b>	Remove crumbs from. <i>A crispy <b>crumb</b> topping.</i>
<b>dessert</b>	The sweet course eaten at the end of a meal. <i>A <b>dessert</b> of chocolate mousse.</i>
<b>flour</b>	Sprinkle something especially a work surface or cooking utensil with a thin layer of flour. <i><b>Flour</b> fish or meat before frying it.</i>
<b>fried</b>	Cooked by frying in fat. <i>A breakfast of <b>fried</b> eggs and bacon.</i>
<b>lasagna</b>	Baked dish of layers of lasagna pasta with sauce and cheese and meat or vegetables.
<b>meal</b>	The food eaten during a meal. <i>The evening <b>meal</b>.</i>
<b>noodle</b>	A ribbonlike strip of pasta. <i>Spicy Sichuan <b>noodles</b>.</i>
<b>pan</b>	Chimpanzees more closely related to Australopithecus than to other pongids. <i>Prospectors <b>panned</b> for gold in the Yukon.</i>
<b>pancake</b>	With reference to an aircraft make or cause to make a pancake landing. <i><b>Pancake</b> batter.</i>
<b>pasta</b>	A dish that contains pasta as its main ingredient.
<b>pastry</b>	An item of food consisting of sweet pastry with a cream jam or fruit filling. <i>Spread the mixture over the <b>pastry</b>.</i>
<b>pie</b>	Dish baked in pastry-lined pan often with a pastry top. <i>A meat <b>pie</b>.</i>
<b>pizza</b>	Italian open pie made of thin bread dough spread with a spiced mixture of e.g. tomato sauce and cheese. <i>A <b>pizza</b> restaurant.</i>
<b>postprandial</b>	Following a meal (especially dinner). <i>We were jolted from our <b>postprandial</b> torpor.</i>
<b>recipe</b>	Something which is likely to lead to a particular outcome. <i>It would be useless to enumerate all the drugs and <b>recipes</b> for their application which have been tried.</i>
<b>recreation</b>	An activity that diverts or amuses or stimulates. <i>Drug abuse is often regarded as a form of <b>recreation</b>.</i>

- refreshment** Snacks and drinks served as a light meal.  
*Light **refreshments** are available.*
- sandwich** Something that is constructed like or has the form of a sandwich.  
*She was **sandwiched** in her airplane seat between two fat men.*
- snack** Eat a snack eat lightly.  
*She never loses weight because she **snacks** between meals.*
- spaghetti** Spaghetti served with a tomato sauce.
- toast** Propose a toast to.  
*He found himself the **toast** of the baseball world.*
