## Associations of "Pathology" (30 Words)

<b>anatomical</b>	An expression that relates to anatomy. <i><b>Anatomical</b> research.</i>
<b><u>anatomy</u></b>	A person’s body. <i>Every part of his <b>anatomy</b> hurt.</i>
<b>autopsy</b>	Perform an autopsy on a body or organ. <i>On <b>autopsy</b> it was established that he had suffered from a rare brain condition.</i>
<b><u>cadaver</u></b>	The dead body of a human being. <i>The <b>cadaver</b> was intended for dissection.</i>
<b>clinical</b>	Relating to the observation and treatment of actual patients rather than theoretical or laboratory studies. <i><b>Clinical</b> medicine.</i>
<b>corpse</b>	Spoil a piece of acting by forgetting one’s lines or laughing uncontrollably. <i>One singer ad libbed and <b>corpse</b>d his colleagues on stage.</i>
<b>cosmetic</b>	Serving an esthetic rather than a useful purpose. <i>The reform package was merely a <b>cosmetic</b> exercise.</i>
<b>dermatology</b>	The branch of medicine dealing with the skin and its diseases.
<b>dissection</b>	A minute and critical analysis. <i>This <b>dissection</b> of modern relationships.</i>
<b>doctor</b>	Remove the sexual organs of (an animal) so that it cannot reproduce. <i>The reports could have been <b>doctored</b>.</i>
<b>ear</b>	Good hearing. <i>She offers a sympathetic <b>ear</b> to worried pet owners.</i>
<b>gynecology</b>	The branch of medicine that deals with the diseases and hygiene of women.

<b>hospital</b>	A charitable institution for the education of the young. <i>Christ's <b>Hospital</b>.</i>
<b>medical</b>	Relating to the study or practice of medicine. <i>He was transferred for further treatment to a <b>medical</b> ward.</i>
<b>medicine</b>	Medicine something that treats or prevents or alleviates the symptoms of disease. <i>Fleur was murdering him by use of bad <b>medicine</b>.</i>
<b>microbiology</b>	The branch of biology that studies microorganisms and their effects on humans.
<b>morgue</b>	A newspaper's collection of miscellaneous information for use in future obituaries. <i>The cadavers were bagged and removed to the city <b>morgue</b>.</i>
<b>morphological</b>	Relating to or concerned with the morphology of plants and animals. <i>The geraniums have a number of unusual <b>morphological</b> adaptations.</i>
<b><u>morphology</u></b>	The branch of biology that deals with the form of living organisms, and with relationships between their structures. <i>Grammar is organized along two main dimensions <b>morphology</b> and syntax.</i>
<b>neurology</b>	Neurology the branch of medicine that deals with the nervous system and its disorders.
<b><u>nose</u></b>	A front that resembles a human nose especially the front of an aircraft. <i>She wanted a good <b>nose</b> round the house.</i>
<b>ophthalmology</b>	The branch of medicine concerned with the study and treatment of disorders and diseases of the eye.
<b>otolaryngology</b>	The study of diseases of the ear and throat.
<b><u>physiological</u></b>	Relating to the branch of biology that deals with the normal functions of living organisms and their parts. <i>Slow down your body's <b>physiological</b> response to anger by breathing deeply.</i>
<b>physiology</b>	The branch of the biological sciences dealing with the functioning of organisms. <i>The <b>physiology</b> of the brain.</i>
<b>psychiatry</b>	The branch of medicine dealing with the diagnosis and treatment of mental disorders.
<b>surgical</b>	Done with great precision, especially with reference to a swift and highly accurate military attack from the air. <i><b>Surgical</b> stockings.</i>

**therapy** The treatment of mental or psychological disorders by psychological means.

*The **therapy** helps the patient to deal with difficult relationships.*

**treatment** Care provided to improve a situation (especially medical procedures or applications that are intended to relieve illness or injury).

*The **treatment** of water sewage.*

**vivisection** The practice of performing operations on live animals for the purpose of experimentation or scientific research (used only by opponents of such work).

*The abolition of **vivisection**.*
