I **pathotype** We **pathotype**
You **pathotype** You **pathotype**
He/She/It **pathotypes** They **pathotype**

Pathotype in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **am pathotyping** We **are pathotyping**
You **are pathotyping** You **are pathotyping**
He/She/It **is pathotyping** They **are pathotyping**
