Definitions of "Patriarchal" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “patriarchal” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Characteristic of a form of social organization in which the male is the family head and title is traced through the male line.*
- *Relating to or characteristic of a man who is older or higher in rank.*
- *Relating to or denoting a system of society or government controlled by men.*
- *Relating to a patriarch.*



Synonyms of "Patriarchal" as an adjective (3 Words)

avuncular Resembling a uncle in kindness or indulgence.
*He was **avuncular** reassuring and trustworthy.*

fatherlike Like or befitting a father or fatherhood; kind and protective.

paternal Relating to or characteristic of or befitting a parent.
*He reasserted his **paternal** authority.*
