avuncular Resembling a uncle in kindness or indulgence. He was avuncular reassuring and trustworthy.

fatherlike Like or befitting a father or fatherhood; kind and protective.

paternal Relating to or characteristic of or befitting a parent. *He reasserted his paternal authority.*
