Singular Plural

I **pay** We **pay**You **pay** You **pay**He/She/It **pays** They **pay**

Pay in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am paying We are paying
You are paying You are paying
He/She/It is paying They are paying

Pay in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have paid or (archaic) payed

You have paid or (archaic) payed

You have paid or (archaic) payed

He/She/It has paid or (archaic) payed

They have paid or (archaic) payed

Pay in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been paying
You have been paying
You have been paying
He/She/It has been paying They have been paying

Pay in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I paid or (archaic) payed
You paid or (archaic) payed
He/She/It paid or (archaic) payed
They paid or (archaic) payed

Pay in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was paying We were paying
You were paying You were paying
He/She/It was paying They were paying

Pay in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had paid or (archaic) payed
You had paid or (archaic) payed
You had paid or (archaic) payed
He/She/It had paid or (archaic) payed
They had paid or (archaic) payed

Pay in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been paying We had been paying
You had been paying You had been paying
He/She/It had been paying They had been paying

Pay in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I will be paying
You will be paying
He/She/It will be paying
They will be paying
