| ethnographic | Relating to the scientific description of peoples and cultures with their customs, habits, and mutual differences. <i>Ethnographical data.</i> |
| ethnology | The branch of anthropology that deals with the division of humankind into races and with their origins and distribution and distinctive characteristics. |
| folklore | The unwritten lore (stories and proverbs and riddles and songs) of a culture. <i>Hollywood folklore.</i> |
| gorilla | A dominant contender within a particular sphere of operation or activity. <i>The 800 lb gorilla of the home mortgage industry.</i> |

| <u>hierarchy</u> | An arrangement or classification of things according to relative importance or inclusiveness. <i>The magazine was read quite widely even by some of the hierarchy.</i> |
| humanity | The quality of being humane; benevolence. <i>Our differences matter but our common humanity matters more.</i> |
| humankind | Human beings considered collectively (used as a neutral alternative to 'mankind'). <i>She always used humankind because mankind seemed to slight the women.</i> |
| independence | The successful ending of the American Revolution. <i>I've always valued my independence.</i> |
| introduce | Put or introduce into something. <i>Introduce exotic fruits.</i> |
| ireland | An island comprising the republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland. |
| man | An adult male human being. <i>He awaited word from his man in Havana.</i> |
| mankind | Human beings considered collectively; the human race. <i>Research for the benefit of all mankind.</i> |
| manlike | Resembling a human being. <i>Women should not be compelled to be manlike.</i> |
| <u>nation</u> | The people who live in a nation or country. <i>The Shawnee nation.</i> |
| <u>national</u> | Owned or maintained for the public by the national government. <i>Isolationism is a strictly national policy.</i> |
| nationality | Distinctive national or ethnic character. <i>Immigrants of the same nationality often seek each other out.</i> |
| nobody | A person of no importance or authority. <i>They went from nobodies to superstars.</i> |
| predestine | (of God) destine (someone) for a particular fate or purpose. <i>Calvinists believed that every person was predestined by God to go to heaven or to hell.</i> |
| racism | Prejudice, discrimination, or antagonism by an individual, community, or institution against a person or people on the basis of their membership of a particular racial or ethnic group, typically one that is a minority or marginalized. <i>Theories of racism.</i> |
| somebody | A human being. |
