<b>american</b>	The English language as used in the United States.
<b>anthropological</b>	Relating to the study of humankind. <i>An <b>anthropological</b> expedition to Borneo.</i>
<b>chieftain</b>	The leader of a group of people. <i>Powerful feudal <b>chieftains</b>.</i>

<b>continent</b>	Having control over urination and defecation. <i>Pioneers had to cross the <b>continent</b> on foot.</i>
<a href="#">country</a>	The people who live in a nation or country. <i>Bible <b>country</b>.</i>
<a href="#">ethnicity</a>	The quality or fact of belonging to a population group or subgroup made up of people who share a common cultural background or descent. <i>The interrelationship between gender <b>ethnicity</b> and class.</i>
<b>ethnographic</b>	Relating to the scientific description of peoples and cultures with their customs, habits, and mutual differences. <i><b>Ethnographical</b> data.</i>
<b>ethnology</b>	The branch of anthropology that deals with the division of humankind into races and with their origins and distribution and distinctive characteristics.
<b>folklore</b>	The unwritten lore (stories and proverbs and riddles and songs) of a culture. <i>Hollywood <b>folklore</b>.</i>
<b>gorilla</b>	A dominant contender within a particular sphere of operation or activity. <i>The 800 lb <b>gorilla</b> of the home mortgage industry.</i>

<a href="#"><u>hierarchy</u></a>	An arrangement or classification of things according to relative importance or inclusiveness. <i>The magazine was read quite widely even by some of the <b>hierarchy</b>.</i>
<b>humanity</b>	The quality of being humane; benevolence. <i>Our differences matter but our common <b>humanity</b> matters more.</i>
<b>humankind</b>	Human beings considered collectively (used as a neutral alternative to 'mankind'). <i>She always used <b>humankind</b> because mankind seemed to slight the women.</i>
<b>independence</b>	The successful ending of the American Revolution. <i>I ve always valued my <b>independence</b>.</i>
<b>introduce</b>	Put or introduce into something. <i><b>Introduce</b> exotic fruits.</i>
<b>ireland</b>	An island comprising the republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland.
<b>man</b>	An adult male human being. <i>He awaited word from his <b>man</b> in Havana.</i>
<b>mankind</b>	Human beings considered collectively; the human race. <i>Research for the benefit of all <b>mankind</b>.</i>
<b>manlike</b>	Resembling a human being. <i>Women should not be compelled to be <b>manlike</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>nation</u></a>	The people who live in a nation or country. <i>The Shawnee <b>nation</b>.</i>
<a href="#"><u>national</u></a>	Owned or maintained for the public by the national government. <i>Isolationism is a strictly <b>national</b> policy.</i>
<b>nationality</b>	Distinctive national or ethnic character. <i>Immigrants of the same <b>nationality</b> often seek each other out.</i>
<b>nobody</b>	A person of no importance or authority. <i>They went from <b>nobodies</b> to superstars.</i>
<b>predestine</b>	(of God) destine (someone) for a particular fate or purpose. <i>Calvinists believed that every person was <b>predestined</b> by God to go to heaven or to hell.</i>
<b>racism</b>	Prejudice, discrimination, or antagonism by an individual, community, or institution against a person or people on the basis of their membership of a particular racial or ethnic group, typically one that is a minority or marginalized. <i>Theories of <b>racism</b>.</i>
<b>somebody</b>	A human being.

tribe

A taxonomic category between a genus and a subfamily.

A United Nations agency to coordinate international health activities and to help governments improve health services.
