- *A fragrant liquid typically made from essential oils extracted from flowers and spices, used to give a pleasant smell to one's body.*
- *A pleasant smell.*
- *A toiletry that emits and diffuses a fragrant odor.*

- aftershave** An astringent scented lotion for applying to the skin after shaving.
- aroma** A subtle, pervasive quality or atmosphere.

fragrance	A pleasant, sweet smell. <i>Men who don't customarily wear fragrance.</i>
odour	The state of being held in a specified regard. <i>A decade of bad odour between Britain and the European Community.</i>
redolence	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.
scent	A distinctive smell, especially one that is pleasant. <i>The scent of freshly cut hay.</i>
smell	A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent. <i>Lingering kitchen smells.</i>
spray	A pesticide in suspension or solution intended for spraying. <i>Refresh your flowers with a quick spray.</i>
toilet water	Misfortune resulting in lost effort or money.

Definitions of "Perfume" as a verb

- *Impregnate with perfume or a sweet-smelling substance.*
- *Fill or impregnate with an odor.*

- *Give a pleasant smell to.*
- *Apply perfume to.*



Synonyms of "Perfume" as a verb (4 Words)

aromatise Fill or impregnate with an odor.

aromatize Give (something) a pleasant and distinctive smell.
*The vinegar has been **aromatized** with plant juices and honey.*

scent Catch the scent of get wind of.
*A shark can **scent** blood from well over half a kilometre away.*

scented Apply perfume to.



Usage Examples of "Perfume" as a verb

- *She perfumes herself every day.*
- *Just one bloom of jasmine has the power to perfume a whole room.*
- *The cream is perfumed with rosemary and iris extracts.*
- *Orange blossoms perfumed the air in the garden.*
- *Her hair was oiled and perfumed.*

- ambergris** A waxy substance that originates as a secretion in the intestines of the sperm whale, found floating in tropical seas and used in perfume manufacture.
- ambrosial** Worthy of the gods.
Ambrosial food.
- aroma** A subtle, pervasive quality or atmosphere.

- aromatic** An aromatic compound.
*An **aromatic** organic compound.*
- cloying** Excessively sweet, rich, or sentimental, especially to a disgusting or sickening degree.
*A romantic rather **cloying** story.*
- cosmetic** Affecting only the appearance of something rather than its substance.
***Cosmetic** creams.*

esthetic	Aesthetically pleasing. <i>The esthetic faculties.</i>
flavorful	Full of flavor.
flowery	Covered with flowers or having a floral design. <i>Flowery wallpaper.</i>
fragrance	A pleasant, sweet smell. <i>The fragrance of fresh ground coffee.</i>
fragrant	Pleasant-smelling. <i>She gathered the fragrant blooms.</i>
incense	Perfume with incense or a similar fragrance. <i>The aroma of cannabis incensed the air.</i>
musk	The scent of a greasy glandular secretion from the male musk deer.
musky	Resembling the smell of musk.
musty	Covered with or smelling of mold. <i>The musty formalities of the occasion.</i>
nectary	A nectar-secreting glandular organ in a flower (floral) or on a leaf or stem (extrafloral).
odor	Any property detected by the olfactory system.
odoriferous	Having a natural fragrance. <i>Odoriferous spices.</i>
odorous	Having or giving off an odour. <i>Fresh odorous bread.</i>
olfaction	The faculty that enables us to distinguish scents.
perfumery	Perfumes in general. <i>A department store perfumery.</i>
pudding	The dessert course of a meal. <i>Corn pudding.</i>
redolent	Noticeably odorous. <i>A rich inky redolent wine.</i>
saccharine	Overly sweet. <i>Saccharine music.</i>
sandalwood	Close grained fragrant yellowish heartwood of the true sandalwood has insect repelling properties and is used for carving and cabinetwork.
scent	Sniff the air for a scent. <i>A shark can scent blood from well over half a kilometre away.</i>

sensory Relating to or concerned in sensation.
*The **sensory** cortex.*

smell A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent.
*Twenty seven cats lived there you can imagine the **smell**.*

sweet In an affectionate or loving manner sweet is sometimes a poetic or informal variant of sweetly Shakespeare.
*A **sweet** shop.*

tasty Pleasing to the sense of taste.
*A **tasty** deal at the building society.*
