<a href="#">everlasting</a>	Any of various plants of various genera of the family Compositae having flowers that can be dried without loss of form or color. <i>Life <b>everlasting</b>.</i>
<a href="#">extend</a>	Extend one's limbs or muscles or the entire body. <i>Her generosity did not <b>extend</b> to all adults.</i>
<a href="#">extension</a>	Permission granted to licensed premises for the sale of alcoholic drinks until later than usual. <i>They applied for an <b>extension</b> of the loan.</i>
<a href="#">forever</a>	For a very long or seemingly endless time. <i>It took <b>forever</b> to get a passport.</i>
<a href="#">incessant</a>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The <b>incessant</b> beat of the music.</i>

<b>indelible</b>	(of ink or a pen) making marks that cannot be removed. <i><b>Indelible</b> memories.</i>
<b>inequality</b>	A symbolic expression of the fact that two quantities are not equal. <i>The growing <b>inequality</b> between rich and poor.</i>
<b>intension</b>	Resolution or determination.
<b>interminable</b>	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i>An <b>interminable</b> sermon.</i>
<b>long</b>	Of elongated shape. <i>A <b>long</b> time.</i>
<b>memory</b>	An electronic memory device. <i>The worst slump in recent <b>memory</b>.</i>
<b>permanent</b>	Lasting or continuing without interruption. <i><b>Permanent</b> secretary to the president.</i>
<b>perpetual</b>	(of a plant) blooming or fruiting several times in one season. <i>A <b>perpetual</b> bond.</i>
<b>perpetually</b>	Without interruption. <i><b>Perpetually</b> hungry teenage boys.</i>
<b>perpetuation</b>	The act of prolonging something. <i><b>Perpetuation</b> of the species is our purpose.</i>
<b>perpetuity</b>	The state or quality of lasting forever. <i>He did not believe in the <b>perpetuity</b> of military rule.</i>
<b>poverty</b>	The state of being inferior in quality or insufficient in amount. <i>Thousands of families are living in abject <b>poverty</b>.</i>
<b>preservation</b>	The activity of protecting something from loss or danger. <i>The chapel is in a poor state of <b>preservation</b>.</i>
<b>prolongation</b>	Extension of the spatial length of something. <i>An agreement on further <b>prolongation</b> of the boundary proved difficult.</i>
<b>reminder</b>	A letter sent to remind someone of an obligation, especially to pay a bill. <i>He ignored his wife's <b>reminders</b>.</i>
<b>stereotype</b>	Treat or classify according to a mental stereotype. <i>The <b>stereotype</b> of the woman as the carer.</i>
<b>timeless</b>	Not affected by the passage of time or changes in fashion. <i>Antiques add to the <b>timeless</b> atmosphere of the dining room.</i>
<b>unceasing</b>	Not coming to an end; continuous. <i>The <b>unceasing</b> efforts of the staff.</i>
