<a href="#">eternal</a>	Used to refer to an everlasting or universal spirit, as represented by God. <i><b>Eternal</b> truths.</i>
<b>everlasting</b>	Lasting forever or a very long time. <i>An <b>everlasting</b> reminder of this evening.</i>
<a href="#">extend</a>	Stretch out over a distance space time or scope run or extend between two points or beyond a certain point. <i><b>Extend</b> the casserole with a little rice.</i>
<a href="#">extension</a>	The spreading of something (a belief or practice) into new regions. <i>A postgraduate <b>extension</b> course.</i>
<a href="#">forever</a>	Without interruption. <i>Parenting is a <b>forever</b> job.</i>
<b>incessant</b>	(of something regarded as unpleasant) continuing without pause or interruption. <i>Night and day we live with the <b>incessant</b> noise of the city.</i>

<b>indelible</b>	Not able to be forgotten. <i>An <b>indelible</b> stain.</i>
<b>inequality</b>	Lack of smoothness or regularity in a surface. <i>The growing <b>inequality</b> between rich and poor.</i>
<b>intension</b>	What you must know in order to determine the reference of an expression.
<b>interminable</b>	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i>An <b>interminable</b> sermon.</i>
<b>long</b>	A long period. <i>A <b>long</b> and distinguished career.</i>
<b>memory</b>	An electronic memory device. <i>He taught a graduate course on learning and <b>memory</b>.</i>
<b>permanent</b>	Continuing or enduring without marked change in status or condition or place. <i><b>Permanent</b> brain damage.</i>
<b>perpetual</b>	(of a plant) blooming or fruiting several times in one season. <i>The <b>perpetual</b> struggle to maintain standards in a democracy.</i>
<b>perpetually</b>	Everlastingly; for all time- Stuart Chase. <i><b>Perpetually</b> hungry teenage boys.</i>
<b>perpetuation</b>	The continuation or preservation of a situation, idea, etc. <i>We criticized the <b>perpetuation</b> of racial stereotypes.</i>
<b>perpetuity</b>	A bond or other security with no fixed maturity date. <i>He did not believe in the <b>perpetuity</b> of military rule.</i>
<b>poverty</b>	The state of being inferior in quality or insufficient in amount. <i>Thousands of families are living in abject <b>poverty</b>.</i>
<b>preservation</b>	The state of being preserved, especially to a specified degree. <i>Food <b>preservation</b>.</i>
<b>prolongation</b>	The act of prolonging something. <i>There was an indefinite <b>prolongation</b> of the peace talks.</i>
<b>reminder</b>	Someone who gives a warning so that a mistake can be avoided. <i>He ignored his wife s <b>reminders</b>.</i>
<b>stereotype</b>	View or represent as a stereotype. <i>Don t treat anyone as a <b>stereotype</b>.</i>
<b>timeless</b>	Unaffected by time. <i>Antiques add to the <b>timeless</b> atmosphere of the dining room.</i>
<b>unceasing</b>	Uninterrupted in time and indefinitely long continuing. <i>The <b>unceasing</b> efforts of the staff.</i>
