aghast	Filled with horror or shock. <i>She winced aghast at his cruelty.</i>
alarmed	Experiencing a sudden sense of danger.
amaze	Be a mystery or bewildering to. <i>Your ability to speak six languages amazes me.</i>
bemuse	Cause to be confused emotionally. <i>He was bemused by what was happening.</i>
bemused	Perplexed by many conflicting situations or statements; filled with bewilderment. <i>Her bemused expression.</i>
bewilder	Be a mystery or bewildering to. <i>His reaction had bewildered her.</i>
bewildered	Perplexed by many conflicting situations or statements; filled with bewilderment. <i>Bewildered and confused.</i>
complicated	Involving complications. <i>Complicated appendicitis.</i>
confound	Mix up (something) with something else. <i>The rise in prices confounded expectations.</i>
confused	Having lost your bearings confused as to time or place or personal identity. <i>A confused expression crossed her face.</i>
confusing	Causing confusion or disorientation. <i>Sent confusing signals to Iraq.</i>
discombobulated	Having self-possession upset; thrown into confusion- G.B.Shaw. <i>The hecklers pelted the discombobulated speaker with anything that came to hand.</i>

disconcerted	Having self-possession upset; thrown into confusion. <i>Looked at each other dumbly quite disconcerted.</i>
dismayed	Struck with fear, dread, or consternation.
disordered	Suffering from an illness or condition that disrupts normal physical or mental functions. <i>She went to comb her disordered hair.</i>
disorganized	Unable to plan one's activities efficiently. <i>The campaign was hopelessly disorganized.</i>
disorient	Cause someone to lose their sense of direction disorientate. <i>The driving snow disoriented them.</i>
illusive	Deceptive; illusory. <i>An illusive haven.</i>
loon	A worthless lazy fellow. <i>If only she weren t such a lovesick loon.</i>
lost	Having lost your bearings confused as to time or place or personal identity. <i>A lost child.</i>
melee	A confused crowd of people. <i>The melee of people that were always thronging the streets.</i>
mistakenly	In a mistaken or erroneous manner. <i>They mistakenly believed her to be pregnant.</i>
perplexing	Completely baffling; very puzzling. <i>A perplexing problem.</i>
puzzled	Unable to understand; perplexed. <i>Puzzled that she left without saying goodbye.</i>
puzzling	Causing one to be puzzled; perplexing. <i>A puzzling statement.</i>
questioning	Showing curiosity. <i>The questioning mind of a child.</i>
quizzical	Playfully vexing (especially by ridicule). <i>He had a quizzical expression.</i>
shocked	Struck with fear, dread, or consternation.
stuck	Caught or fixed. <i>This problem has me completely stuck.</i>
surprised	Feeling or showing surprise. <i>Surprised that he remembered my name.</i>
