Definitions of "Personalized" as an adjective

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "personalized" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- (especially of a deity or spirit) personified.
- Identifiable as belonging to a particular person, especially by being marked with their name or initials.
- Pointedly referring to or concerning a person's individual personality or intimate affairs especially offensively.
- (of an issue, argument, etc.) concerned with personalities or feelings rather than with general or abstract matters.
- Designed or produced to meet someone's individual requirements.
- Made for or directed or adjusted to a particular individual.
