Past Participle	philosophated

Conjugate Philosophate

Philosophate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **philosophate** We **philosophate**
You **philosophate** You **philosophate**
He/She/It **philosophates** They **philosophate**

Philosophate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am philosophating** We **are philosophating**
You **are philosophating** You **are philosophating**
He/She/It **is philosophating** They **are philosophating**

Philosophate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have philosophated** We **have philosophated**
You **have philosophated** You **have philosophated**
He/She/It **has philosophated** They **have philosophated**

Philosophate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I **have been philosophating** We **have been philosophating**
You **have been philosophating** You **have been philosophating**
He/She/It **has been philosophating** They **have been philosophating**

I **philosophated** We **philosophated**
You **philosophated** You **philosophated**
He/She/It **philosophated** They **philosophated**

Philosophate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was philosophating We were philosophating
You were philosophating You were philosophating
He/She/It was philosophating They were philosophating

Philosophate in Past Perfect Tense

I had philosophated We had philosophated
You had philosophated You had philosophated
He/She/It had philosophated They had philosophated

Philosophate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been philosophating We had been philosophating
You had been philosophating You had been philosophating
He/She/It had been philosophating They had been philosophating

Philosophate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will philosophate We will philosophate
You will philosophate You will philosophate
He/She/It will philosophate They will philosophate

Philosophate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be philosophating We will be philosophating
You will be philosophating You will be philosophating
He/She/It will be philosophating They will be philosophating

Philosophate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have philosophated

We will have philosophated

You will have philosophated

You will have philosophated

He/She/It will have philosophated **They will have philosophated**

Philosophate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been philosophating

We will have been philosophating

You will have been philosophating

You will have been philosophating

He/She/It will have been philosophating **They will have been philosophating**
