Philosophy in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **philosophy**You **philosophy**He/She/It **philosophies** They **philosophy**

Philosophy in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am philosophying We are philosophying
You are philosophying You are philosophying
He/She/It is philosophying They are philosophying

Philosophy in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have philosophied We have philosophied You have philosophied You have philosophied He/She/It has philosophied They have philosophied

Philosophy in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been philosophying
You have been philosophying
He/She/It has been philosophying
They have been philosophying

Philosophy in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **philosophied** We **philosophied**You **philosophied** You **philosophied**He/She/It **philosophied** They **philosophied**

Philosophy in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was philosophying We were philosophying
You were philosophying You were philosophying
He/She/It was philosophying They were philosophying

Philosophy in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had philosophied We had philosophied
You had philosophied You had philosophied
He/She/It had philosophied They had philosophied

Philosophy in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been philosophying We had been philosophying
You had been philosophying You had been philosophying
He/She/It had been philosophying They had been philosophying

Philosophy in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **will philosophy**You **will philosophy**He/She/It **will philosophy**They **will philosophy**

Philosophy in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be philosophying
You will be philosophying
He/She/It will be philosophying
They will be philosophying

Philosophy in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have philosophied We will have philosophied You will have philosophied He/She/It will have philosophied They will have philosophied

I will have been philosophying
You will have been philosophying
He/She/It will have been philosophying
They will have been philosophying
