## Associations of "Photogenic" (30 Words)

<b>advisory</b>	Recommended but not compulsory. <i>The Commission acts in an <b>advisory</b> capacity.</i>
<b>archetypal</b>	Recurrent as a symbol or motif in literature, art, or mythology. <i>The <b>archetypal</b> country doctor.</i>
<a href="#"><b>archetype</b></a>	A very typical example of a certain person or thing. <i>Mythological <b>archetypes</b> of good and evil.</i>
<a href="#"><b>buxom</b></a>	(of a woman's body) having a large bosom and pleasing curves. <i>A generation ago <b>buxom</b> actresses were popular.</i>
<a href="#"><b>camera</b></a>	A device for recording visual images in the form of photographs, film, or video signals. <i>She faced the <b>cameras</b>.</i>
<b>display</b>	Attract attention by displaying some body part or posing of animals. <i>The palace used to <b>display</b> a series of tapestries.</i>
<a href="#"><b>epitome</b></a>	A summary of a written work; an abstract. <i>She looked the <b>epitome</b> of elegance and good taste.</i>
<b>example</b>	A representative form or pattern. <i>There is an <b>example</b> on page 10.</i>
<b>fashion</b>	A popular or the latest style of clothing, hair, decoration, or behaviour. <i>She <b>fashioned</b> a tent out of a sheet and a few sticks.</i>
<b>herbarium</b>	A room or building housing a herbarium.
<b>illustration</b>	Showing by example. <i>By way of <b>illustration</b> I refer to the following case.</i>
<b>lattice</b>	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. <i>The lift stopped and he peered through the metal <b>lattice</b>.</i>
<b>lifelike</b>	Evoking lifelike images within the mind. <i>A <b>lifelike</b> pose.</i>

<b>mannequin</b>	A woman who wears clothes to display fashions. <i>She was too fat to be a <b>mannequin</b>.</i>
<b>model</b>	Construct a model of. <i>He s been <b>modelling</b> for just two weeks.</i>
<b>paradigm</b>	The class of all items that can be substituted into the same position or slot in a grammatical sentence are in paradigmatic relation with one another. <i>He framed the problem within the psychoanalytic <b>paradigm</b>.</i>
<b>paradigmatic</b>	Of or relating to a grammatical paradigm. <i>His biography is <b>paradigmatic</b> of the experiences of this generation.</i>
<b>personality</b>	Lively, engaging qualities. <i>She had a sunny <b>personality</b> that was very engaging.</i>
<b>polymorphous</b>	Occurring in several different forms or stages. <i>A <b>polymorphous</b> organism.</i>
<b>prototype</b>	Make a prototype of a product. <i>He is the <b>prototype</b> of good breeding.</i>
<b>replica</b>	A duplicate of an original artistic work. <i>It is a <b>replica</b> of an antique plaque.</i>
<b>sample</b>	Take a sample or samples of something for analysis. <i>They shared these characteristics with other women in the <b>sample</b>.</i>
<b>screening</b>	Refuse separated by sieving grain. <i>The less than successful <b>screening</b> of the sitcom s pilot episode.</i>
<b>simulation</b>	The act of giving a false appearance. <i><b>Simulation</b> of blood flowing through arteries and veins.</i>
<b>specimen</b>	A bit of tissue or blood or urine that is taken for diagnostic purposes. <i>Carla could not help feeling a degree of reluctant admiration for this odd female <b>specimen</b>.</i>
<b>spheroid</b>	A solid generated by a half revolution of an ellipse about its major axis prolate spheroid or minor axis oblate spheroid. <i>It looked like a sphere but on closer examination I saw it was really a <b>spheroid</b>.</i>
<b>tripod</b>	A stool, table, or cauldron resting on three legs.
<b>type</b>	Determine the type to which a person or their blood or tissue belongs. <i>The word element contains five different <b>types</b> of character.</i>
<b>typify</b>	Embody the essential characteristics of or be a typical example of. <i>The sun typified the Greeks, and the moon the Persians.</i>
<b>winsome</b>	Charming in a childlike or naive way. <i>A <b>winsome</b> smile.</i>
