Photograph in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I photograph	We photograph
You photograph	You photograph
He/She/It photographs	They photograph

Photograph in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am photographing	We are photographing
You are photographing	You are photographing
He/She/It is photographing	They are photographing

Photograph in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have photographed	We have photographed
You have photographed	You have photographed
He/She/It has photographed	They have photographed

Photograph in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been photographing	We have been photographing
You have been photographing	You have been photographing
He/She/It has been photographing	They have been photographing

Photograph in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I photographed	We photographed
You photographed	You photographed
He/She/It photographed	They photographed

Photograph in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was photographing	We were photographing
You were photographing	You were photographing
He/She/It was photographing	They were photographing

Photograph in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had photographed	We had photographed
You had photographed	You had photographed
He/She/It had photographed	They had photographed

Photograph in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been photographing	We had been photographing
You had been photographing	You had been photographing
He/She/It had been photographing	They had been photographing

Photograph in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will photograph	We will photograph
You will photograph	You will photograph
He/She/It will photograph	They will photograph

Photograph in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be photographing	We will be photographing
You will be photographing	You will be photographing
He/She/It will be photographing	They will be photographing

Photograph in Future Perfect Tense



Singular	Plural
I will have photographed	We will have photographed
You will have photographed	You will have photographed
He/She/It will have photographed	They will have photographed

Photograph in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I will have been photographing	We will have been photographing
You will have been photographing	You will have been photographing
He/She/It will have been photographing	They will have been photographing
