- *(of a place or building) visually attractive, especially in a quaint or charming way.*
- *Strikingly expressive.*

<u>impressive</u>	Making a strong or vivid impression. <i>Gave an impressive performance as Othello.</i>
lovely	Lovable especially in a childlike or naive way. <i>We ve had a lovely day.</i>
pleasing	Giving pleasure and satisfaction. <i>A pleasing aroma.</i>
<u>pretty</u>	Pleasing by delicacy or grace; not imposing. <i>He led me a pretty dance.</i>
quaint	Attractively unusual or old-fashioned. <i>Quaint streets of New Orleans that most foreign of American cities.</i>
<u>romantic</u>	Relating to or denoting the artistic and literary movement of romanticism. <i>After their romantic relationship ended they became great friends.</i>
scenic	Used of locations; having beautiful natural scenery. <i>Scenic drives.</i>
<u>striking</u>	Sensational in appearance or thrilling in effect. <i>A striking landscape.</i>
<u>vivid</u>	Having the highest saturation. <i>Memories of that evening were still vivid.</i>

Provide with background.

*The house stands against a **background** of sheltering trees.*

Delighting the senses or exciting intellectual or emotional admiration.

beauty

A very attractive or seductive looking woman.

*The artistry and **beauty** of football.*

colored

Artificially produced; not natural.

*Amber **colored** heads of grain.*

colorful

Having striking color.

*A **colorful** character.*

diorama	A scenic painting, viewed through a peephole, in which changes in colour and direction of illumination simulate changes in the weather, time of day, etc.
gaily	Without thinking of the consequences. <i>She plunged gaily into speculation on the stock market.</i>
gorgeous	Very pleasant or enjoyable. <i>Gorgeous colours and exquisite decoration.</i>
iridescent	Showing luminous colours that seem to change when seen from different angles. <i>A dragonfly hovered vibrating and iridescent.</i>
landscape	Do landscape gardening. <i>Landscape format.</i>
monochromatic	Having only one wavelength. <i>It employs diffraction to focus monochromatic light.</i>
monochrome	(of a photograph or picture, or a television screen) consisting of or displaying images in black and white or in varying tones of only one colour.
painted	Coated with paint. <i>Freshly painted lawn furniture.</i>
panoramic	Including all aspects of a subject; wide-ranging. <i>On a clear day there are panoramic views.</i>
piebald	A piebald horse. <i>A piebald horse.</i>
pied	Having two or more different colours. <i>The pied flycatcher.</i>
polychrome	Color with many colors make polychrome. <i>A precious polychrome ikon.</i>
pomp	Cheap or pretentious or vain display. <i>Entertaining overseas visitors with the right degree of pomp.</i>
rainbow	An arch of colours visible in the sky caused by the refraction and dispersion of the sun's light by rain or other water droplets in the atmosphere. The colours of the rainbow are generally said to be red orange yellow green blue indigo and violet. <i>All the colours of the rainbow.</i>
roan	A roan animal. <i>A blue roan.</i>

scenery	The painted structures of a stage set that are intended to suggest a particular locale. <i>They had all helped with scenery and costumes.</i>
scenic	Used of locations; having beautiful natural scenery. <i>Scenic beauty.</i>
tricolor	Having or involving three colors. <i>Tricolor plumage.</i>
<u>various</u>	Considered individually. <i>His disguises are many and various.</i>
<u>vibrant</u>	(of sound) strong or resonating. <i>A vibrant group that challenged the system.</i>
<u>vista</u>	A mental view of a succession of remembered or anticipated events. <i>Vistas of freedom seemed to open ahead of him.</i>
<u>vivid</u>	Evoking lifelike images within the mind. <i>Vivid green.</i>
wonderful	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>They all think she s wonderful.</i>
