## Associations of "Planting" (30 Words)

<b>anther</b>	The part of the stamen that contains pollen; usually borne on a stalk.
<b>aster</b>	Any of various chiefly fall-blooming herbs of the genus <i>Aster</i> with showy daisylike flowers.
<b>bean</b>	A leguminous plant that bears beans in pods. <i>I didn't know <b>beans</b> about being a step parent.</i>
<b><u>blossom</u></b>	A flower or a mass of flowers, especially on a tree or bush. <i>Youth <b>blossomed</b> into maturity.</i>
<b>bud</b>	Develop buds. <i>In certain limbless lizards and snakes a limb <b>bud</b> develops.</i>
<b>chaff</b>	Worthless things; rubbish. <i>He hopes to separate scientifically supported claims from pseudoscientific <b>chaff</b>.</i>
<b>conservatory</b>	The faculty and students of a school specializing in one of the fine arts. <i>Keep plant cuttings in a frost free <b>conservatory</b> or greenhouse.</i>
<b>corn</b>	Ears of corn that can be prepared and served for human food. <i><b>Corned</b> beef.</i>
<b><u>crop</u></b>	Yield crops. <i>Hay would have been <b>cropped</b> several times through the summer.</i>
<b>cultivation</b>	The process of fostering the growth of something. <i>The <b>cultivation</b> of arable crops.</i>
<b>flower</b>	The state or period in which a plant's flowers have developed and opened. <i>He wasted the <b>flower</b> of French youth on his dreams of empire.</i>
<b>forestry</b>	The science or practice of planting, managing, and caring for forests.
<b>graft</b>	Insert a shoot or twig as a graft. <i>They can <b>graft</b> a new hand on to the nerve ends.</i>
<b>herbaceous</b>	Denoting or relating to herbs (in the botanical sense).

<b>hothouse</b>	An environment that encourages rapid growth or development, especially in a stifling or intense way. <i>The <b>hothouse</b> atmosphere of the college.</i>
<b>orchard</b>	A piece of enclosed land planted with fruit trees. <i>A cider <b>orchard</b>.</i>
<b>ovule</b>	A small or immature ovum.
<b>pedicel</b>	A small stalk bearing an individual flower in an inflorescence.
<b>plant</b>	Cover or supply an area of land with plants. <i>They built a large <b>plant</b> to manufacture automobiles.</i>
<u><b>plantation</b></u>	An area in which trees have been planted, especially for commercial purposes. <i>New conifer <b>plantations</b>.</i>
<b>planter</b>	A worker who puts or sets seeds or seedlings into the ground. <i>Wealthy coffee <b>planters</b>.</i>
<b>pollen</b>	A fine powdery substance typically yellow consisting of microscopic grains discharged from the male part of a flower or from a male cone Each grain contains a male gamete that can fertilize the female ovule to which pollen is transported by the wind insects or other animals.
<b>reforestation</b>	The restoration (replanting) of a forest that had been reduced by fire or cutting. <i>The need for post fire <b>reforestation</b>.</i>
<b>seed</b>	Remove the seeds from vegetables or fruit. <i>As he promised to our forefathers Abraham and his <b>seed</b>.</i>
<b>seedling</b>	Young plant or tree grown from a seed.
<u><b>sprout</b></u>	Put forth and grow sprouts or shoots. <i>Crocuses <b>sprouted</b> up from the grass.</i>
<u><b>stalk</b></u>	A stalklike support for a sessile animal or for an organ in an animal. <i>Her ex boyfriend <b>stalked</b> her.</i>
<b>tree</b>	Stretch a shoe on a shoetree. <i>The hunters <b>treed</b> the bear with dogs and killed it.</i>
<u><b>vine</b></u>	A climbing or trailing woody stemmed plant related to the grapevine. <i>The <b>vines</b> of a vast wisteria.</i>
