The science or practice of planting, managing, and caring for forests.
Insert a shoot or twig as a graft. They can <b>graft</b> a new hand on to the nerve ends.
Denoting or relating to herbs (in the botanical sense).



hothouse	An environment that encourages rapid growth or development, especially in a stifling or intense way. The <b>hothouse</b> atmosphere of the college.
orchard	A piece of enclosed land planted with fruit trees. A cider <b>orchard</b> .
ovule	A small or immature ovum.
pedicel	A small stalk bearing an individual flower in an inflorescence.
plant	Cover or supply an area of land with plants. They built a large <b>plant</b> to manufacture automobiles.
<u>plantation</u>	An area in which trees have been planted, especially for commercial purposes. New conifer <b>plantations</b> .
planter	A worker who puts or sets seeds or seedlings into the ground. Wealthy coffee <b>planter</b> s.
pollen	A fine powdery substance typically yellow consisting of microscopic grains discharged from the male part of a flower or from a male cone Each grain contains a male gamete that can fertilize the female ovule to which pollen is transported by the wind insects or other animals.
reforestation	The restoration (replanting) of a forest that had been reduced by fire or cutting. The need for post fire <b>reforestation</b> .
seed	Remove the seeds from vegetables or fruit. As he promised to our forefathers Abraham and his <b>seed</b> .
seedling	Young plant or tree grown from a seed.
<u>sprout</u>	Put forth and grow sprouts or shoots. Crocuses <b>sprout</b> ed up from the grass.
<u>stalk</u>	A stalklike support for a sessile animal or for an organ in an animal. <i>Her ex boyfriend <b>stalk</b>ed her.</i>
tree	Stretch a shoe on a shoetree. The hunters <b>tree</b> d the bear with dogs and killed it.
<u>vine</u>	A climbing or trailing woody stemmed plant related to the grapevine. <i>The vines of a vast wisteria.</i>
