Associations of "Planting" (30 Words)

anther	The part of the stamen that contains pollen; usually borne on a stalk.
aster	Any of various chiefly fall-blooming herbs of the genus Aster with showy daisylike flowers.
bean	A leguminous plant that bears beans in pods. <i>I didn't know beans about being a step parent.</i>
<u>blossom</u>	A flower or a mass of flowers, especially on a tree or bush. <i>Youth blossomed into maturity.</i>
bud	Develop buds. <i>In certain limbless lizards and snakes a limb bud develops.</i>
chaff	Worthless things; rubbish. <i>He hopes to separate scientifically supported claims from pseudoscientific chaff.</i>
conservatory	The faculty and students of a school specializing in one of the fine arts. <i>Keep plant cuttings in a frost free conservatory or greenhouse.</i>
corn	Ears of corn that can be prepared and served for human food. <i>Corned beef.</i>
<u>crop</u>	Yield crops. <i>Hay would have been cropped several times through the summer.</i>
cultivation	The process of fostering the growth of something. <i>The cultivation of arable crops.</i>
flower	The state or period in which a plant's flowers have developed and opened. <i>He wasted the flower of French youth on his dreams of empire.</i>
forestry	The science or practice of planting, managing, and caring for forests.
graft	Insert a shoot or twig as a graft. <i>They can graft a new hand on to the nerve ends.</i>
herbaceous	Denoting or relating to herbs (in the botanical sense).

hothouse	An environment that encourages rapid growth or development, especially in a stifling or intense way. <i>The hothouse atmosphere of the college.</i>
orchard	A piece of enclosed land planted with fruit trees. <i>A cider orchard.</i>
ovule	A small or immature ovum.
pedicel	A small stalk bearing an individual flower in an inflorescence.
plant	Cover or supply an area of land with plants. <i>They built a large plant to manufacture automobiles.</i>
plantation	An area in which trees have been planted, especially for commercial purposes. <i>New conifer plantations.</i>
planter	A worker who puts or sets seeds or seedlings into the ground. <i>Wealthy coffee planters.</i>
pollen	A fine powdery substance typically yellow consisting of microscopic grains discharged from the male part of a flower or from a male cone Each grain contains a male gamete that can fertilize the female ovule to which pollen is transported by the wind insects or other animals.
reforestation	The restoration (replanting) of a forest that had been reduced by fire or cutting. <i>The need for post fire reforestation.</i>
seed	Remove the seeds from vegetables or fruit. <i>As he promised to our forefathers Abraham and his seed.</i>
seedling	Young plant or tree grown from a seed.
sprout	Put forth and grow sprouts or shoots. <i>Crocuses sprouted up from the grass.</i>
stalk	A stalklike support for a sessile animal or for an organ in an animal. <i>Her ex boyfriend stalked her.</i>
tree	Stretch a shoe on a shoetree. <i>The hunters treed the bear with dogs and killed it.</i>
vine	A climbing or trailing woody stemmed plant related to the grapevine. <i>The vines of a vast wisteria.</i>
