Present Tense	<b>play / plays</b>
Past Tense	<b>played</b>
Present Participle	<b>playing</b>
Past Participle	<b>played</b>

## Conjugate Play

**Play in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>play</b>	We <b>play</b>
You <b>play</b>	You <b>play</b>
He/She/It <b>plays</b>	They <b>play</b>

## **Play in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am playing</b>	We <b>are playing</b>
You <b>are playing</b>	You <b>are playing</b>
He/She/It <b>is playing</b>	They <b>are playing</b>

## **Play in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have played</b>	We <b>have played</b>
You <b>have played</b>	You <b>have played</b>
He/She/It <b>has played</b>	They <b>have played</b>

## **Play in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been playing</b>	We <b>have been playing</b>
You <b>have been playing</b>	You <b>have been playing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been playing</b>	They <b>have been playing</b>

## **Play in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>played</b>	We <b>played</b>
You <b>played</b>	You <b>played</b>
He/She/It <b>played</b>	They <b>played</b>

## **Play in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular****Plural**

<b>I was playing</b>	<b>We were playing</b>
<b>You were playing</b>	<b>You were playing</b>
<b>He/She/It was playing</b>	<b>They were playing</b>

**Play in Past Perfect Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had played</b>	<b>We had played</b>
<b>You had played</b>	<b>You had played</b>
<b>He/She/It had played</b>	<b>They had played</b>

**Play in Past Perfect Continuous Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I had been playing</b>	<b>We had been playing</b>
<b>You had been playing</b>	<b>You had been playing</b>
<b>He/She/It had been playing</b>	<b>They had been playing</b>

**Play in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will play</b>	<b>We will play</b>
<b>You will play</b>	<b>You will play</b>
<b>He/She/It will play</b>	<b>They will play</b>

**Play in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense****Singular****Plural**

<b>I will be playing</b>	<b>We will be playing</b>
<b>You will be playing</b>	<b>You will be playing</b>
<b>He/She/It will be playing</b>	<b>They will be playing</b>

**I will have played**

**We will have played**

**You will have played**

**You will have played**

**He/She/It will have played**

**They will have played**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been playing**

**We will have been playing**

**You will have been playing**

**You will have been playing**

**He/She/It will have been playing**

**They will have been playing**
