game.



hopeless Beyond hope of management or reform.

He is a **hopeless** romantic.

idle (of money) held in cash or in accounts paying no interest.

in vain Directed or bound inward.

needless Unnecessary and unwarranted.

A strikers tent camp was burned with **needless** loss of life.

otiose Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being.

An **otiose** undertaking.

purposeless Having no aim or plan.

A life essentially **purposeless**.

scoreless

Denoting a game or match in which no goals, points, or runs are scored.

A **scoreless** inning.

senseless Incapable of sensation.

In Vietnam I saw the **senseless** waste of human beings.

Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being.

superfluous

Delete superfluous or unnecessary words.

to no purpose Quantifier; used with either mass nouns or plural count nouns for

indicating a complete or almost complete lack or zero quantity of.

Producing no result or effect.

unavailing

An unavailing attempt.

unpointedNot having a sharpened or tapered tip.

Lumps of exposed brick with **unpointed** mortar.

unproductive Not producing or capable of producing.

Elimination of high cost or **unproductive** industries.

(of a business or activity) not yielding profit or financial gain.

unprofitable There has been much **unprofitable** speculation.

Having no ability or skill in a specified activity or area.

We tried to pacify him but it was **useless**.

valueless Of no value.

Cherished but **valueless** heirlooms.


wasted Under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
