### Definitions of "Pointless" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “pointless” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not having a point especially a sharp point.*
- *Having no points scores.*
- *Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being.*
- *Having little or no sense, use, or purpose.*



## Synonyms of "Pointless" as an adjective (23 Words)

### aimless

Aimlessly drifting.  
An **aimless** existence.

### **fruitless**

Unproductive of success.  
A **fruitless** search.

### futile

Unproductive of success.  
A **futile** effort.

### **goalless**

Denoting a game of soccer, rugby, etc. in which no goals are scored.  
Nothing excites me I m a **goalless** person right now.

### **hitless**

Without a hit.  
The fans who adore him will remember his speech and not his **hitless** game.

<b>hopeless</b>	Beyond hope of management or reform. <i>He is a <b>hopeless</b> romantic.</i>
<b>idle</b>	(of money) held in cash or in accounts paying no interest. <i><b>Idle</b> funds.</i>
<b>in vain</b>	Directed or bound inward.
<b>needless</b>	Unnecessary and unwarranted. <i>A strikers tent camp was burned with <b>needless</b> loss of life.</i>
<b>otiose</b>	Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being. <i>An <b>otiose</b> undertaking.</i>
<b>purposeless</b>	Having no aim or plan. <i>A life essentially <b>purposeless</b>.</i>
<b>scoreless</b>	Denoting a game or match in which no goals, points, or runs are scored. <i>A <b>scoreless</b> inning.</i>
<b>senseless</b>	Incapable of sensation. <i>In Vietnam I saw the <b>senseless</b> waste of human beings.</i>
<b>superfluous</b>	Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being. <i>Delete <b>superfluous</b> or unnecessary words.</i>
<b>to no purpose</b>	Quantifier; used with either mass nouns or plural count nouns for indicating a complete or almost complete lack or zero quantity of.
<b>unavailing</b>	Producing no result or effect. <i>An <b>unavailing</b> attempt.</i>
<b>unpointed</b>	Not having a sharpened or tapered tip. <i>Lumps of exposed brick with <b>unpointed</b> mortar.</i>
<b><u>unproductive</u></b>	Not producing or capable of producing. <i>Elimination of high cost or <b>unproductive</b> industries.</i>
<b>unprofitable</b>	(of a business or activity) not yielding profit or financial gain. <i>There has been much <b>unprofitable</b> speculation.</i>
<b><u>useless</u></b>	Having no ability or skill in a specified activity or area. <i>We tried to pacify him but it was <b>useless</b>.</i>
<b>valueless</b>	Of no value. <i>Cherished but <b>valueless</b> heirlooms.</i>
<b><u>wasted</u></b>	Under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs. <i><b>Wasted</b> fuel.</i>
<b>worthless</b>	Morally reprehensible. <i>A <b>worthless</b> idler.</i>

- *It's pointless to plan too far ahead.*
- *A pointless remark.*
- *Speculating like this is a pointless exercise.*
