- Having little or no sense, use, or purpose.






## Synonyms of "Pointless" as an adjective (23 Words)

<u>aimless</u>	Aimlessly drifting. An <b>aimless</b> existence.
fruitless	Unproductive of success. A <b>fruitless</b> search.
<u>futile</u>	Unproductive of success. A <b>futile</b> effort.
goalless	Denoting a game of soccer, rugby, etc. in which no goals are scored. Nothing excites me I m a <b>goalless</b> person right now.
hitless	Without a hit. The fans who adore him will remember his speech and not his <b>hitless</b> game.



hopeless	Beyond hope of management or reform. <i>He is a <b>hopeless</b> romantic.</i>
idle	(of money) held in cash or in accounts paying no interest. <i>Idle funds.</i>
in vain	Directed or bound inward.
needless	Unnecessary and unwarranted. A strikers tent camp was burned with <b>needless</b> loss of life.
otiose	Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being. An <b>otiose</b> undertaking.
purposeless	Having no aim or plan. A life essentially <b>purposeless</b> .
scoreless	Denoting a game or match in which no goals, points, or runs are scored. A <i>scoreless inning</i> .
senseless	Incapable of sensation. In Vietnam I saw the <b>senseless</b> waste of human beings.
superfluous	Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being. Delete <b>superfluous</b> or unnecessary words.
to no purpose	Quantifier; used with either mass nouns or plural count nouns for indicating a complete or almost complete lack or zero quantity of.
unavailing	Producing no result or effect. An <b>unavailing</b> attempt.
unpointed	Not having a sharpened or tapered tip. Lumps of exposed brick with <b>unpointed</b> mortar.
<u>unproductive</u>	Not producing or capable of producing. Elimination of high cost or <b>unproductive</b> industries.
unprofitable	(of a business or activity) not yielding profit or financial gain. <i>There has been much <b>unprofitable</b> speculation.</i>
<u>useless</u>	Having no ability or skill in a specified activity or area. We tried to pacify him but it was <b>useless</b> .
valueless	Of no value. Cherished but <b>valueless</b> heirlooms.
<u>wasted</u>	Under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs. <i>Wasted</i> fuel.
worthless	Morally reprehensible. A <b>worthless</b> idler.
