Prairie-dog in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **prairie-dog** We **prairie-dog**
You **prairie-dog** You **prairie-dog**
He/She/It **prairie-dogs** They **prairie-dog**

Prairie-dog in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am prairie-dogging** We **are prairie-dogging**
You **are prairie-dogging** You **are prairie-dogging**
He/She/It **is prairie-dogging** They **are prairie-dogging**

Prairie-dog in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have prairie-dogged** We **have prairie-dogged**
You **have prairie-dogged** You **have prairie-dogged**
He/She/It **has prairie-dogged** They **have prairie-dogged**

Prairie-dog in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was prairie-dogging We were prairie-dogging
You were prairie-dogging You were prairie-dogging
He/She/It was prairie-dogging They were prairie-dogging

Prairie-dog in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

I had prairie-dogged We had prairie-dogged
You had prairie-dogged You had prairie-dogged
He/She/It had prairie-dogged They had prairie-dogged

Prairie-dog in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I had been prairie-dogging We had been prairie-dogging
You had been prairie-dogging You had been prairie-dogging
He/She/It had been prairie-dogging They had been prairie-dogging

Prairie-dog in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will prairie-dog We will prairie-dog
You will prairie-dog You will prairie-dog
He/She/It will prairie-dog They will prairie-dog

Prairie-dog in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be prairie-dogging We will be prairie-dogging
You will be prairie-dogging You will be prairie-dogging
He/She/It will be prairie-dogging They will be prairie-dogging

I will have prairie-dogged

We will have prairie-dogged

You will have prairie-dogged

You will have prairie-dogged

He/She/It will have prairie-dogged **They will have prairie-dogged**

I will have been prairie-dogging

We will have been prairie-dogging

You will have been prairie-dogging
