Infinitive	to precipitate
Present Tense	precipitate / precipitates
Past Tense	precipitated
Present Participle	precipitating
Past Participle	precipitated

# **Conjugate Precipitate**

#### Precipitate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>precipitate</b>	We <b>precipitate</b>
You <b>precipitate</b>	You <b>precipitate</b>
He/She/It precipitates	They <b>precipitate</b>

#### **Precipitate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am precipitating	We are precipitating
You <b>are precipitating</b>	You are precipitating
He/She/It is precipitating	They are precipitating

#### **Precipitate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have precipitated	We have precipitated
You have precipitated	You have precipitated
He/She/It has precipitated	They have precipitated

#### **Precipitate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been precipitating	We have been precipitating
You <b>have been precipitating</b>	You have been precipitating
He/She/It has been precipitating	They have been precipitating

### **Precipitate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I precipitated	We <b>precipitated</b>
You <b>precipitated</b>	You <b>precipitated</b>
He/She/It precipitated	They <b>precipitated</b>

#### **Precipitate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was precipitating	We were precipitating
You were precipitating	You were precipitating
He/She/It was precipitating	They were precipitating

#### **Precipitate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had precipitated	We had precipitated
You had precipitated	You had precipitated
He/She/It had precipitated	They had precipitated

#### **Precipitate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been precipitating	We had been precipitating
You had been precipitating	You had been precipitating
He/She/It had been precipitating	They had been precipitating

## **Precipitate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will precipitate	We will precipitate
You <b>will precipitate</b>	You <b>will precipitate</b>
He/She/It will precipitate	They will precipitate

## **Precipitate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be precipitating	We will be precipitating
You <b>will be precipitating</b>	You will be precipitating
He/She/It will be precipitating	They will be precipitating

#### **Precipitate in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have precipitatedWe will have precipitatedYou will have precipitatedYou will have precipitatedHe/She/It will have precipitatedThey will have precipitated

#### **Precipitate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been precipitating	We will have been precipitating
You will have been precipitating	You will have been precipitating
He/She/It will have been precipitating	They will have been precipitating
