<b>conspicuous</b>	Without any attempt at concealment; completely obvious. <i>He was very thin with a <b>conspicuous</b> Adam s apple.</i>
<b>detectable</b>	Easily seen or detected. <i>An easily <b>detectable</b> and treatable disorder.</i>
<b>discernible</b>	Capable of being seen or noticed. <i>An essay with a meaning that was not always <b>discernible</b>.</i>
<b>distinctly</b>	In a way that is readily distinguishable by the senses; clearly. <i>Two <b>distinctly</b> different cultures.</i>
<b>eminent</b>	(of a person) famous and respected within a particular sphere. <i>The book s scholarship and <b>eminent</b> readability.</i>
<b>evident</b>	Clearly seen or understood; obvious. <i>A clearly <b>evident</b> erasure in the manuscript.</i>
<b>manifest</b>	Record in a ship s manifest. <i><b>Manifest</b> disapproval.</i>
<b>marked</b>	Strongly marked easily noticeable. <i>A scar <b>marked</b> face.</i>
<b>marvelous</b>	Too improbable to admit of belief. <i>A <b>marvelous</b> collection of rare books.</i>
<b>memorable</b>	Worth remembering. <i>He recalled <b>memorable</b> moments in his life.</i>
<b>notable</b>	Worthy of attention or notice; remarkable. <i>The gardens are <b>notable</b> for their collection of magnolias and camellias.</i>
<b>noted</b>	Widely known and esteemed. <i>The restaurant is <b>noted</b> for its high standards of cuisine.</i>
<b>noteworthy</b>	Worth paying attention to; interesting or significant. <i>A <b>noteworthy</b> fact is that her students rarely complain.</i>
<b>noticeable</b>	Undesirably noticeable. <i>After a <b>noticeable</b> pause the lecturer continued.</i>
<b>observable</b>	Capable of being seen or noticed. <i><b>Observable</b> differences.</i>
<b>obtrusive</b>	Noticeable or prominent in an unwelcome or intrusive way. <i>Equally <b>obtrusive</b> was the graffiti.</i>
<b>obvious</b>	Easily perceived by the senses or grasped by the mind. <i>It was an <b>obvious</b> remark to make.</i>

<b>outstanding</b>	Distinguished from others in excellence. <i>Much of the work is still <b>outstanding</b>.</i>
<b>perceptible</b>	Easily perceived by the senses or grasped by the mind. <i>A <b>perceptible</b> limp.</i>
<b><u>phenomenal</u></b>	Remarkable or exceptional, especially exceptionally good. <i>The <b>phenomenal</b> world.</i>
<b>prominent</b>	Important; famous. <i>A new theory is the most <b>prominent</b> feature of the book.</i>
<b>pronounced</b>	Very noticeable or marked; conspicuous. <i>A <b>pronounced</b> flavor of cinnamon.</i>
<b>remarkable</b>	Worthy of notice. <i>A <b>remarkable</b> achievement.</i>
<b>renowned</b>	Widely known and esteemed. <i>A <b>renowned</b> author.</i>
<b><u>striking</u></b>	The action of striking. <i>His <b>striking</b> good looks always created a sensation.</i>
<b><u>substantial</u></b>	Concerning the essentials of something. <i>Breakfast is a <b>substantial</b> buffet.</i>
<b>visibly</b>	In a way that is visible to the eye. <i>The defendant paled <b>visibly</b> as the guilty verdict was announced.</i>
