Infinitive	to prefer
Present Tense	prefer / prefers
Past Tense	preferred
Present Participle	preferring
Past Participle	preferred

Conjugate Prefer

Prefer in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **prefer** We **prefer**
You **prefer** You **prefer**
He/She/It **prefers** They **prefer**

Prefer in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am preferring** We **are preferring**
You **are preferring** You **are preferring**
He/She/It **is preferring** They **are preferring**

Prefer in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have preferred** We **have preferred**
You **have preferred** You **have preferred**
He/She/It **has preferred** They **have preferred**

Prefer in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been preferring** We **have been preferring**
You **have been preferring** You **have been preferring**
He/She/It **has been preferring** They **have been preferring**

Prefer in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **preferred** We **preferred**
You **preferred** You **preferred**
He/She/It **preferred** They **preferred**

Prefer in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was preferring We were preferring
You were preferring You were preferring
He/She/It was preferring They were preferring

Prefer in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had preferred We had preferred
You had preferred You had preferred
He/She/It had preferred They had preferred

Prefer in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been preferring We had been preferring
You had been preferring You had been preferring
He/She/It had been preferring They had been preferring

Prefer in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will prefer We will prefer
You will prefer You will prefer
He/She/It will prefer They will prefer

Prefer in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be preferring We will be preferring
You will be preferring You will be preferring
He/She/It will be preferring They will be preferring

Prefer in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have preferred

We will have preferred

You will have preferred

You will have preferred

He/She/It will have preferred **They will have preferred**

Prefer in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been preferring

We will have been preferring

You will have been preferring

You will have been preferring

He/She/It will have been preferring **They will have been preferring**
