Conjugate Prejudicate

Prejudicate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **prejudicate**You **prejudicate**He/She/It **prejudicates**They **prejudicate**

Prejudicate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am prejudicating We are prejudicating
You are prejudicating You are prejudicating
He/She/It is prejudicating They are prejudicating

Prejudicate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have prejudicated We have prejudicated You have prejudicated He/She/It has prejudicated They have prejudicated

Prejudicate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been prejudicating
You have been prejudicating
He/She/It has been prejudicating
They have been prejudicating

Prejudicate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **prejudicated** We **prejudicated**You **prejudicated** You **prejudicated**He/She/It **prejudicated** They **prejudicated**

Prejudicate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was prejudicating We were prejudicating
You were prejudicating You were prejudicating
He/She/It was prejudicating They were prejudicating

Prejudicate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had prejudicated We had prejudicated You had prejudicated You had prejudicated He/She/It had prejudicated They had prejudicated

Prejudicate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been prejudicating
You had been prejudicating
He/She/It had been prejudicating
They had been prejudicating

Prejudicate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will prejudicate
You will prejudicate
He/She/It will prejudicate
They will prejudicate

Prejudicate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be prejudicating
You will be prejudicating
He/She/It will be prejudicating
They will be prejudicating

Prejudicate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have prejudicated We will have prejudicated You will have prejudicated He/She/It will have prejudicated They will have prejudicated

Prejudicate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been prejudicating
You will have been prejudicating
He/She/It will have been prejudicating
They will have been prejudicating
