Infinitive	to premier
Present Tense	premier / premiers
Past Tense	premiered
Present Participle	premiering
Past Participle	premiered

# **Conjugate Premier**

#### **Premier in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>premier</b>	We <b>premier</b>
You <b>premier</b>	You <b>premier</b>
He/She/It <b>premiers</b>	They <b>premier</b>

## **Premier in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am premiering	We are premiering
You <b>are premiering</b>	You <b>are premiering</b>
He/She/It is premiering	They are premiering

### **Premier in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have premiered	We have premiered
You <b>have premiered</b>	You have premiered
He/She/It has premiered	They have premiered

## **Premier in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been premiering	We have been premiering
You <b>have been premiering</b>	You <b>have been premiering</b>
He/She/It has been premiering	They have been premiering

## **Premier in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I premiered	We <b>premiered</b>
You <b>premiered</b>	You <b>premiered</b>
He/She/It <b>premiered</b>	They <b>premiered</b>

#### **Premier in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was premiering	We were premiering
You <b>were premiering</b>	You were premiering
He/She/It was premiering	They were premiering

#### **Premier in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had premiered	We had premiered
You had premiered	You had premiered
He/She/It had premiered	They had premiered

### **Premier in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been premiering	We had been premiering
You <b>had been premiering</b>	You had been premiering
He/She/It had been premiering	They had been premiering

## Premier in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will premier	We will premier
You <b>will premier</b>	You <b>will premier</b>
He/She/It will premier	They will premier

## **Premier in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be premiering	We will be premiering
You <b>will be premiering</b>	You will be premiering
He/She/It will be premiering	They will be premiering

#### **Premier in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have premieredWe will have premieredYou will have premieredYou will have premieredHe/She/It will have premieredThey will have premiered

#### **Premier in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been premiering	We <b>will have been premiering</b>
You <b>will have been premiering</b>	You <b>will have been premiering</b>
He/She/It will have been premiering	They will have been premiering
