<b><u>elemental</u></b>	Relating to or being an element. <i>Failure is always apparent at this <b>elemental</b> level.</i>
<b>elements</b>	Violent or severe weather viewed as caused by the action of the four elements. <i>They felt the full fury of the <b>elements</b>.</i>
<b>essential</b>	Absolutely necessary; extremely important. <i>Funds <b>essential</b> to the completion of the project.</i>
<b><u>front</u></b>	Act as a front or cover for illegal or secret activity. <i>She rolled over on to her <b>front</b>.</i>
<b>indispensability</b>	The quality possessed by something that you cannot possibly do without.
<b><u>indispensable</u></b>	Absolutely necessary; vitally necessary. <i>The routine but <b>indispensable</b> ceremonies of state.</i>
<b><u>integral</u></b>	The result of a mathematical integration $F(x)$ is the integral of $f(x)$ if $dF/dx = f(x)$ . <i>The first <b>integral</b> recording of the ten Mahler symphonies.</i>
<b><u>main</u></b>	The source of public water, gas, or electricity supply through pipes or cables. <i>Switch off the <b>mains</b> supply.</i>
<b>meaningful</b>	Having a recognizable function in a logical language or other sign system. <i>A <b>meaningful</b> discussion.</i>
<b><u>must</u></b>	The quality of smelling or tasting old or stale or mouldy. <i>She said she <b>must</b> be going.</i>
<b>necessary</b>	Needed to be done, achieved, or present; essential. <i>They granted the <b>necessary</b> planning permission.</i>
<b>necessity</b>	The principle according to which something must be so, by virtue either of logic or of natural law. <i>The <b>necessity</b> of growing old.</i>
<b>need</b>	Have or feel a need for. <i>He had sufficient means to meet his simple <b>needs</b>.</i>

<b>needs</b>	Of necessity. <i>We must <b>needs</b> by objective.</i>
<b>obligate</b>	Commit in order to fulfill an obligation. <i>The money must be <b>obligated</b> within 30 days.</i>
<b>perforce</b>	Used to express necessity or inevitability. <i>Amateurs <b>perforce</b> have to settle for less expensive solutions.</i>
<u><b>primary</b></u>	A primary coil or winding in an electrical transformer. <i>His expert handling of the <b>primary</b> and secondary literature is clear on every page.</i>
<u><b>prior</b></u>	The head of a religious order in an abbey the prior is next below the abbot. <i>He had no juvenile record no <b>priors</b>.</i>
<b>proviso</b>	A condition or qualification attached to an agreement or statement. <i>He let his house with the <b>proviso</b> that his own staff should remain to run it.</i>
<b>required</b>	Required by rule. <i><b>Required</b> reading.</i>
<b>requisite</b>	Made necessary by particular circumstances or regulations. <i>A place where the <b>requisites</b> of water fuel and fodder can be obtained.</i>
<u><b>staple</b></u>	Attach or secure with a staple or staples. <i><b>Staple</b> fibers vary widely in length.</i>
<u><b>unavoidable</b></u>	Not able to be avoided, prevented, or ignored; inevitable. <i>An <b>unavoidable</b> accident.</i>
<u><b>underlying</b></u>	Located beneath or below. <i><b>Underlying</b> problems need to be addressed.</i>
<u><b>vital</b></u>	Urgently needed; absolutely necessary. <i>Of <b>vital</b> interest.</i>
