Synonyms of "Presentable" as an adjective (19 Words)

clean	Ritually clean or pure. <i>I had been here for only a fortnight and clean for three weeks.</i>
dapper	Neat and trim in dress and appearance (typically used of a man). <i>He looked very dapper in a dark silk suit.</i>
elegant	Suggesting taste, ease, and wealth. <i>An elegant comfortable house.</i>
fit to be seen	Physically and mentally sound or healthy.
in apple-pie order	Directed or bound inward.
in good order	Holding office.
neat	Done with or demonstrating skill or efficiency. <i>He drank neat Scotch.</i>
of smart appearance	Painfully severe.

orderly	Devoid of violence or disruption. <i>The orderly sergeant.</i>
shipshape	Of places; characterized by order and neatness; free from disorder. <i>He checked that everything was shipshape.</i>
shipshape and bristol fashion	Of places; characterized by order and neatness; free from disorder.
smart	(of a person) clean, tidy, and well dressed. <i>Smart children talk earlier than the average.</i>
smartly dressed	Capable of independent and apparently intelligent action.
spruce	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners.
straight	Simple straightforward. <i>He made sure his tie was straight.</i>
tidily dressed	Large in amount or extent or degree.
tidy	Neat and tidy. <i>She was a tidy little girl.</i>
trim	Thin and fit. <i>A trim little sailboat.</i>
well groomed	Resulting favorably.
