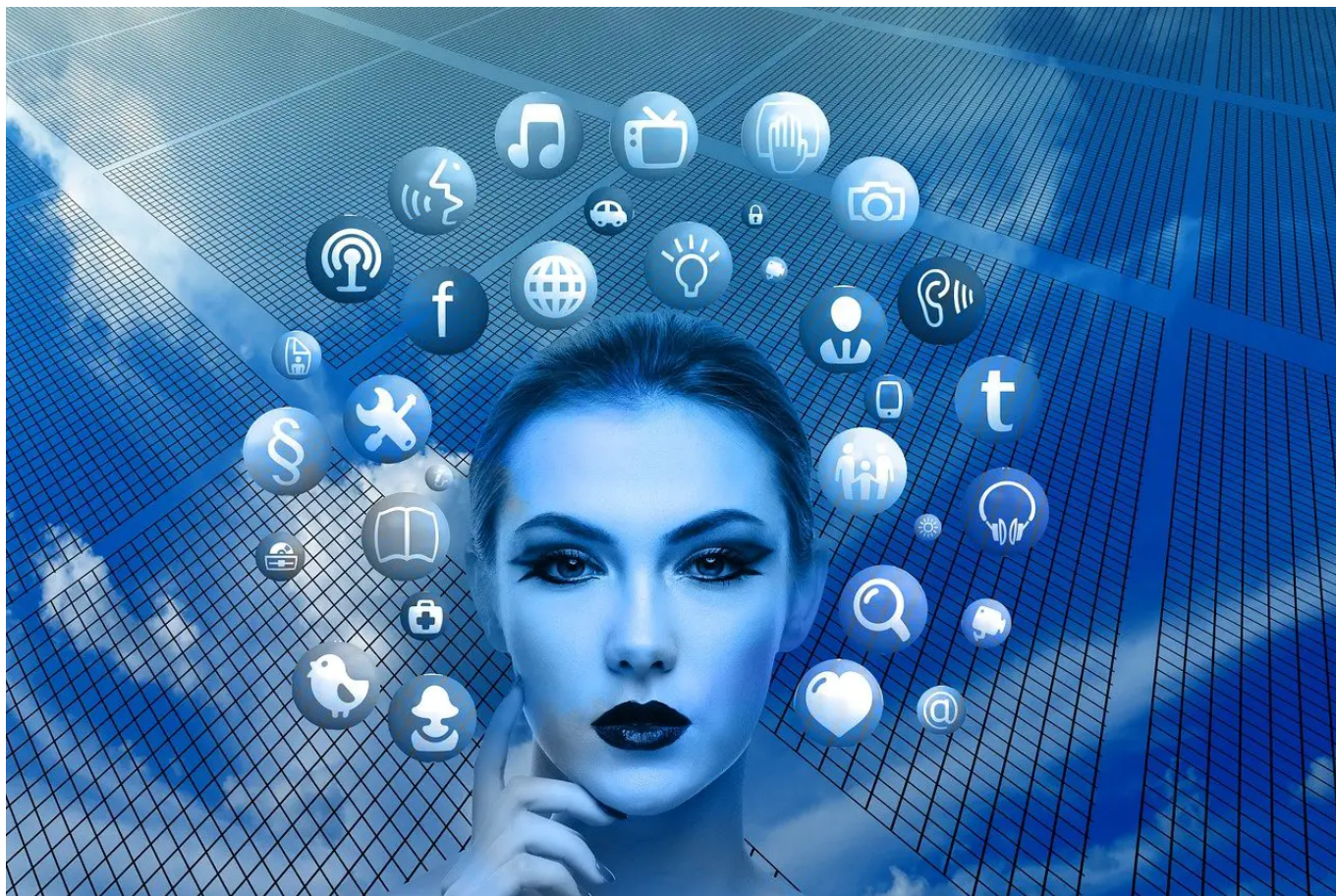

- *Fit to be seen.*
- *Clean, smart, or decent enough to be seen in public.*



## Synonyms of "Presentable" as an adjective (19 Words)

<b>clean</b>	Ritually clean or pure. <i>I had been here for only a fortnight and <b>clean</b> for three weeks.</i>
<b>dapper</b>	Neat and trim in dress and appearance (typically used of a man). <i>He looked very <b>dapper</b> in a dark silk suit.</i>
<b>elegant</b>	Suggesting taste, ease, and wealth. <i>An <b>elegant</b> comfortable house.</i>
<b>fit to be seen</b>	Physically and mentally sound or healthy.
<b>in apple-pie order</b>	Directed or bound inward.
<b>in good order</b>	Holding office.
<b>neat</b>	Done with or demonstrating skill or efficiency. <i>He drank <b>neat</b> Scotch.</i>
<b>of smart appearance</b>	Painfully severe.

<b>orderly</b>	Devoid of violence or disruption. <i>The <b>orderly</b> sergeant.</i>
<b>shipshape</b>	Of places; characterized by order and neatness; free from disorder. <i>He checked that everything was <b>shipshape</b>.</i>
<b>shipshape and bristol fashion</b>	Of places; characterized by order and neatness; free from disorder.
<b>smart</b>	(of a person) clean, tidy, and well dressed. <i><b>Smart</b> children talk earlier than the average.</i>
<b>smartly dressed</b>	Capable of independent and apparently intelligent action.
<b>spruce</b>	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners.
<b><u>straight</u></b>	Simple straightforward. <i>He made sure his tie was <b>straight</b>.</i>
<b>tidily dressed</b>	Large in amount or extent or degree.
<b><u>tidy</u></b>	Neat and tidy. <i>She was a <b>tidy</b> little girl.</i>
<b>trim</b>	Thin and fit. <i>A <b>trim</b> little sailboat.</i>
<b>well groomed</b>	Resulting favorably.
