Associations of "Pressed" (30 Words)

bazaar	A shop where a variety of goods are sold. <i>The church bazaar.</i>
clump	Form a clump or clumps. <i>The particles tend to clump together.</i>
compact	A mass of powdered metal compacted together in preparation for sintering. <i>The foundation of the walls compacted of Granite and Lime.</i>
compactly	In a compact manner or state. <i>He wrote compactly but clearly.</i>
compendious	Briefly giving the gist of something. <i>A short and compendious book.</i>
compress	Flatten by pressure; squeeze or press. <i>Compress the data.</i>
compressed	Reduced in volume by pressure. <i>Compressed earth blocks.</i>
compression	An increase in the density of something.
concise	Giving a lot of information clearly and in a few words; brief but comprehensive. <i>A concise explanation.</i>
condense	Compress or concentrate. <i>Her feelings condensed.</i>
connote	Involve as a necessary condition of consequence; as in logic. <i>Spinsterhood connoted failure.</i>
constrict	Become tight or as if tight. <i>Her throat constricted.</i>
constricted	Inhibited; restricted. <i>A constricted blood vessel.</i>

<u>crowded</u>	(of a space) full of people, leaving little or no room for movement; packed. <i>A very crowded room.</i>
dense	Hard to pass through because of dense growth. <i>She made her way through the dense undergrowth.</i>
filled	Of purchase orders that have been filled. <i>Fog filled air.</i>
impenetrable	Impossible to understand. <i>Impenetrable rain forests.</i>
jammed	Extremely crowded or filled to capacity. <i>A suitcase jammed with dirty clothes.</i>
<u>lush</u>	Characterized by extravagance and profusion. <i>These architecture magazines are full of the lush interiors of the rich and famous.</i>
narrowed	Reduced in size as by squeezing together. <i>His narrowed eyes.</i>
nonporous	Not porous; especially not having vessels that appear as pores.
<u>packed</u>	Pressed together or compressed. <i>Packed snow.</i>
refrigerant	Causing cooling or freezing. <i>A refrigerant substance such as ice or solid carbon dioxide.</i>
<u>teeming</u>	Abundantly filled with especially living things. <i>The Third World s teeming millions.</i>
<u>thick</u>	Spoken as if with a thick tongue. <i>Stephen woke late his head thick and his mouth sour.</i>
thickly	With thickness; in a thick manner. <i>A field thickly coated with snow.</i>
<u>thorough</u>	Painstakingly careful and accurate. <i>The child is being a thorough nuisance.</i>
tight	Pulled or drawn tight. <i>The bolts are tight.</i>
tightly	With very firm or strict control. <i>A tightly sealed container.</i>
underbrush	The brush (small trees and bushes and ferns etc.) growing beneath taller trees in a wood or forest.
