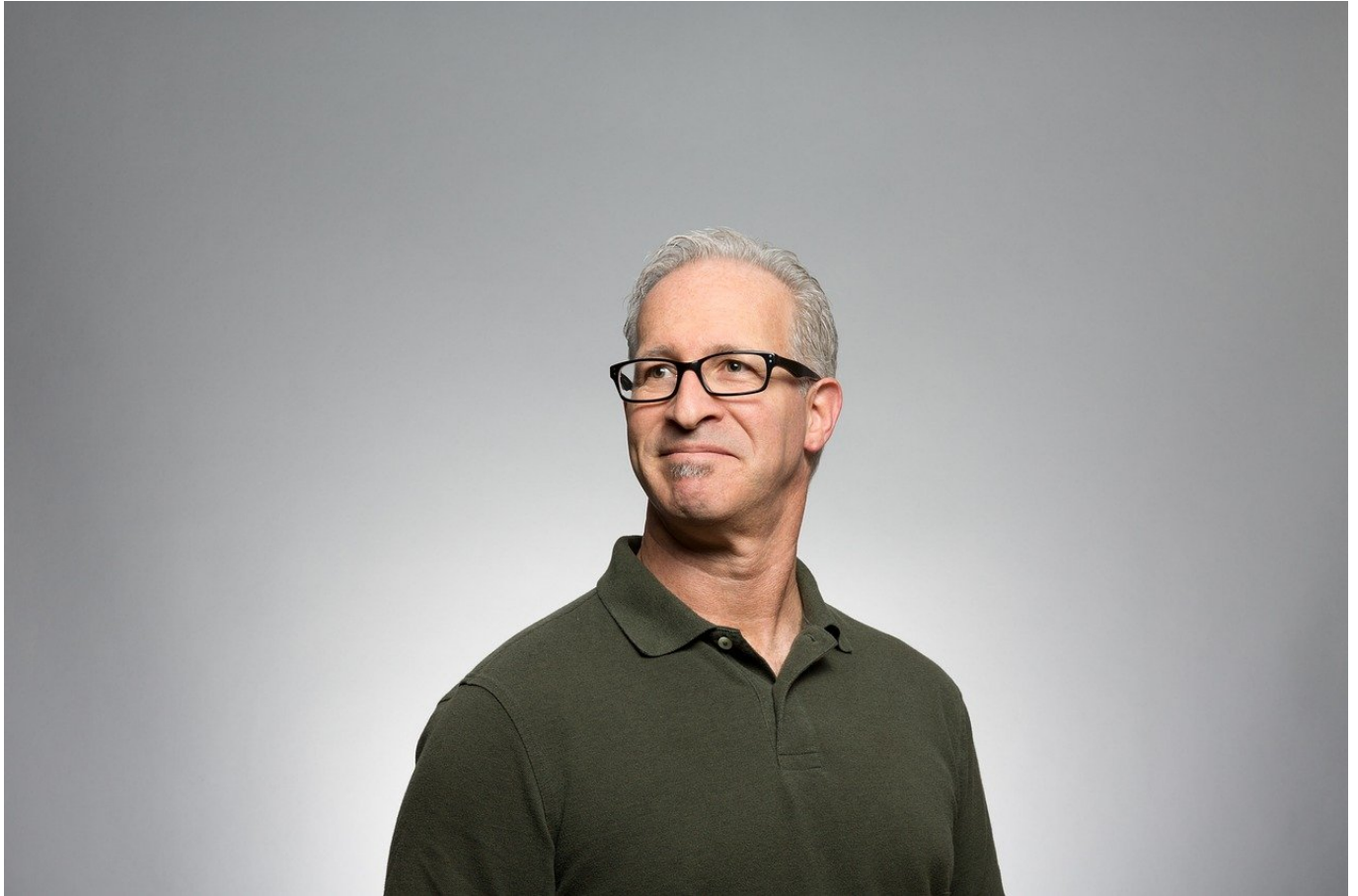

### **Definitions of "Prideful" as an adjective**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “prideful” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Having an excessively high opinion of oneself.*
- *Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy.*
- *Joyful and proud especially because of triumph or success.*



## Synonyms of "Prideful" as an adjective (14 Words)

- disdainful** Showing contempt or lack of respect.  
*With a last **disdainful** look she turned towards the door.*
- exultant** Triumphantly happy.  
*He waved to the **exultant** crowds.*
- exulting** Joyful and proud especially because of triumph or success.  
*He gave an **exulting** cry.*
- haughty** Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy.  
*A **haughty** British aristocrat.*
- imperious** Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy.  
*His **imperious** demands.*
- jubilant** Joyful and proud especially because of triumph or success.  
*A large number of **jubilant** fans ran on to the pitch.*

- lordly** Of or befitting a lord.  
*Heir to a **lordly** fortune.*
- overbearing** Expecting unquestioning obedience.  
*An **overbearing** ill tempered brute.*
- rejoicing** Joyful and proud especially because of triumph or success.  
***Rejoicing** crowds filled the streets on VJ Day.*
- sniffy** Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy.  
*Very **sniffy** about breaches of etiquette.*
- supercilious** Expressive of contempt.  
*His mother eyed my clothes with a **supercilious** air.*
- swaggering** Flamboyantly adventurous.  
*A **swaggering** bully.*
- triumphal** Made, carried out, or used in celebration of a great victory or achievement.  
*A **triumphal** success.*
- triumphant** Experiencing triumph.  
*A **triumphant** shout.*



## Usage Examples of "Prideful" as an adjective

- *Walked with a prideful swagger.*
- *A stern and prideful schoolmaster.*
