Principiate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **principiate** We **principiate**You **principiate** You **principiate**He/She/It **principiates** They **principiate**

Principiate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am principiating We are principiating
You are principiating You are principiating
He/She/It is principiating They are principiating

Principiate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have principiated We have principiated You have principiated He/She/It has principiated They have principiated

Principiate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been principiating

You have been principiating

You have been principiating

He/She/It has been principiating

They have been principiating

Principiate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **principiated** We **principiated**You **principiated** You **principiated**He/She/It **principiated** They **principiated**

Principiate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was principiating We were principiating
You were principiating You were principiating
He/She/It was principiating They were principiating

Principiate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had principiated We had principiated
You had principiated You had principiated
He/She/It had principiated They had principiated

Principiate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been principiating
You had been principiating
He/She/It had been principiating
They had been principiating

Principiate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will principiate We will principiate
You will principiate You will principiate
He/She/It will principiate They will principiate

Principiate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be principiating
You will be principiating
He/She/It will be principiating
They will be principiating

Principiate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have principiated We will have principiated You will have principiated He/She/It will have principiated They will have principiated

Principiate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been principiating
You will have been principiating
He/She/It will have been principiating
They will have been principiating
