Probate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I probate	We probate
You probate	You probate
He/She/It probates	They probate

Probate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am probating	We are probating
You are probating	You are probating
He/She/It is probating	They are probating

Probate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have probated	We have probated
You have probated	You have probated
He/She/It has probated	They have probated

Probate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been probating	We have been probating
You have been probating	You have been probating
He/She/It has been probating	They have been probating

Probate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I probated	We probated
You probated	You probated
He/She/It probated	They probated

Probate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was probating	We were probating
You were probating	You were probating
He/She/It was probating	They were probating

Probate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had probated	We had probated
You had probated	You had probated
He/She/It had probated	They had probated

Probate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been probating	We had been probating
You had been probating	You had been probating
He/She/It had been probating	They had been probating

Probate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will probate	We will probate
You will probate	You will probate
He/She/It will probate	They will probate

Probate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be probating	We will be probating
You will be probating	You will be probating
He/She/It will be probating	They will be probating
