I **problem-solve** We **problem-solve**
You **problem-solve** You **problem-solve**
He/She/It **problem-solves** They **problem-solve**

Problem-solve in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I **am problem-solving** We **are problem-solving**
You **are problem-solving** You **are problem-solving**
He/She/It **is problem-solving** They **are problem-solving**

Problem-solve in Present Perfect Tense

I **have problem-solved** We **have problem-solved**
You **have problem-solved** You **have problem-solved**
He/She/It **has problem-solved** They **have problem-solved**

Problem-solve in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I was problem-solving We were problem-solving
You were problem-solving You were problem-solving
He/She/It was problem-solving They were problem-solving

I had problem-solved We had problem-solved
You had problem-solved You had problem-solved
He/She/It had problem-solved They had problem-solved

Problem-solve in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

I had been problem-solving We had been problem-solving
You had been problem-solving You had been problem-solving
He/She/It had been problem-solving They had been problem-solving

You will problem-solve You will problem-solve
He/She/It will problem-solve They will problem-solve
