Infinitive	to profer
Present Tense	profer / profers
Past Tense	proferred
Present Participle	proferring
Past Participle	proferred

# **Conjugate Profer**

## **Profer in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>profer</b>	We <b>profer</b>
You <b>profer</b>	You <b>profer</b>
He/She/It <b>profers</b>	They <b>profer</b>

## **Profer in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am proferring	We <b>are proferring</b>
You <b>are proferring</b>	You <b>are proferring</b>
He/She/It is proferring	They are proferring

### **Profer in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have proferred	We have proferred
You have proferred	You have proferred
He/She/It has proferred	They have proferred

## **Profer in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been proferring	We have been proferring
You <b>have been proferring</b>	You <b>have been proferring</b>
He/She/It has been proferring	They have been proferring

## **Profer in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I proferred	We <b>proferred</b>
You <b>proferred</b>	You <b>proferred</b>
He/She/It proferred	They <b>proferred</b>

## **Profer in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was proferringWe were proferringYou were proferringYou were proferringHe/She/It was proferringThey were proferring

### **Profer in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had proferred	We had proferred
You had proferred	You had proferred
He/She/It had proferred	They had proferred

### **Profer in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been proferring	We had been proferring
You <b>had been proferring</b>	You had been proferring
He/She/It had been proferring	They had been proferring

## **Profer in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will profer	We will profer
You <b>will profer</b>	You <b>will profer</b>
He/She/It will profer	They will profer

## **Profer in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be proferring	We will be proferring
You <b>will be proferring</b>	You will be proferring
He/She/It will be proferring	They will be proferring

### **Profer in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have proferredWe will have proferredYou will have proferredYou will have proferredHe/She/It will have proferredThey will have proferred

### **Profer in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been proferring	We <b>will have been proferring</b>
You <b>will have been proferring</b>	You <b>will have been proferring</b>
He/She/It will have been proferring They will have been proferring
