Present Participle	proferring
Past Participle	proffered

Conjugate Profer

Profer in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **profer** We **profer**
You **profer** You **profer**
He/She/It **profers** They **profer**

Profer in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am proffering** We **are proffering**
You **are proffering** You **are proffering**
He/She/It **is proffering** They **are proffering**

Profer in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have proffered** We **have proffered**
You **have proffered** You **have proffered**
He/She/It **has proffered** They **have proffered**

Profer in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been proffering** We **have been proffering**
You **have been proffering** You **have been proffering**
He/She/It **has been proffering** They **have been proffering**

Profer in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **proffered** We **proffered**
You **proffered** You **proffered**
He/She/It **proffered** They **proffered**

Profer in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was preferring We were preferring
You were preferring You were preferring
He/She/It was preferring They were preferring

Profer in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had proferred We had proferred
You had proferred You had proferred
He/She/It had proferred They had proferred

Profer in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been preferring We had been preferring
You had been preferring You had been preferring
He/She/It had been preferring They had been preferring

Profer in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will profer We will profer
You will profer You will profer
He/She/It will profer They will profer

Profer in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be preferring We will be preferring
You will be preferring You will be preferring
He/She/It will be preferring They will be preferring

Profer in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have proferred

We will have proferred

You will have proferred

You will have proferred

He/She/It will have proferred

They will have proferred

Profer in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been proferring

We will have been proferring

You will have been proferring

You will have been proferring

He/She/It will have been proferring

They will have been proferring
