# **Conjugate Profligate**

#### **Profligate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>profligate</b>	We <b>profligate</b>
You <b>profligate</b>	You <b>profligate</b>
He/She/It <b>profligates</b>	They <b>profligate</b>

#### **Profligate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am profligating	We <b>are profligating</b>
You <b>are profligating</b>	You <b>are profligating</b>
He/She/It is profligating	They are profligating

#### **Profligate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have profligated	We have profligated
You <b>have profligated</b>	You have profligated
He/She/It has profligated	They have profligated

### **Profligate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been profligating	We have been profligating
You <b>have been profligating</b>	You have been profligating
He/She/It has been profligating	They have been profligating

## **Profligate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I profligated	We <b>profligated</b>
You <b>profligated</b>	You <b>profligated</b>
He/She/It <b>profligated</b>	They <b>profligated</b>

#### **Profligate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was profligating	We were profligating
You were profligating	You were profligating
He/She/It was profligating	They were profligating

#### **Profligate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had profligated	We had profligated
You had profligated	You had profligated
He/She/It had profligated	They had profligated

#### **Profligate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been profligating	We <b>had been profligating</b>
You <b>had been profligating</b>	You <b>had been profligating</b>
He/She/It had been profligating	They had been profligating

### **Profligate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will profligate	We will profligate
You <b>will profligate</b>	You <b>will profligate</b>
He/She/It will profligate	They will profligate

## **Profligate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be profligating	We will be profligating
You <b>will be profligating</b>	You will be profligating
He/She/It will be profligating	They will be profligating
