I **profligate**                      We **profligate**  
You **profligate**                    You **profligate**  
He/She/It **profligates**      They **profligate**

**Profligate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am profligating**                We **are profligating**  
You **are profligating**            You **are profligating**  
He/She/It **is profligating**      They **are profligating**

**Profligate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have profligated**                We **have profligated**  
You **have profligated**            You **have profligated**  
He/She/It **has profligated**      They **have profligated**

I **have been profligating**        We **have been profligating**  
You **have been profligating**      You **have been profligating**  
He/She/It **has been profligating**      They **have been profligating**

You were profligating      You were profligating  
He/She/It was profligating      They were profligating

He/She/It had been profligating      They had been profligating

You will profligate      You will profligate  
He/She/It will profligate      They will profligate

You will be profligating      You will be profligating  
He/She/It will be profligating      They will be profligating
