Infinitive	to profuse
Present Tense	profuse / profuses
Past Tense	profused
Present Participle	profusing
Past Participle	profused

# **Conjugate Profuse**

## **Profuse in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>profuse</b>	We <b>profuse</b>
You <b>profuse</b>	You <b>profuse</b>
He/She/It <b>profuses</b>	They <b>profuse</b>

## **Profuse in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am profusing	We <b>are profusing</b>
You <b>are profusing</b>	You <b>are profusing</b>
He/She/It is profusing	They are profusing

#### **Profuse in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have profused	We have profused
You have profused	You have profused
He/She/It has profused	They have profused

## **Profuse in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been profusing	We have been profusing
You have been profusing	You have been profusing
He/She/It has been profusing	They have been profusing

## **Profuse in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I profused	We <b>profused</b>
You <b>profused</b>	You <b>profused</b>
He/She/It <b>profused</b>	They <b>profused</b>

#### **Profuse in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was profusing	We were profusing
You <b>were profusing</b>	You were profusing
He/She/It was profusing	They were profusing

#### **Profuse in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had profused	We had profused
You had profused	You had profused
He/She/It had profused	They had profused

## **Profuse in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been profusing	We had been profusing
You <b>had been profusing</b>	You had been profusing
He/She/It had been profusing	They had been profusing

## **Profuse in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will profuse	We <b>will profuse</b>
You <b>will profuse</b>	You <b>will profuse</b>
He/She/It will profuse	They will profuse

## **Profuse in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be profusing	We will be profusing
You <b>will be profusing</b>	You <b>will be profusing</b>
He/She/It will be profusing	They will be profusing

## **Profuse in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have profusedWe will have profusedYou will have profusedYou will have profusedHe/She/It will have profusedThey will have profused

### **Profuse in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been profusing	We <b>will have been profusing</b>
You <b>will have been profusing</b>	You <b>will have been profusing</b>
He/She/It will have been profusing They will have been profusing
