## Conjugate Prog

**Prog in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular      Plural**

I **prog**                      We **prog**  
You **prog**                  You **prog**  
He/She/It **progs**      They **prog**

### **Prog in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                      Plural**

I **am proggng**              We **are proggng**  
You **are proggng**        You **are proggng**  
He/She/It **is proggng**      They **are proggng**

### **Prog in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                      Plural**

I **have proggd**              We **have proggd**  
You **have proggd**        You **have proggd**  
He/She/It **has proggd**      They **have proggd**

### **Prog in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                      Plural**

I **have been proggng**        We **have been proggng**  
You **have been proggng**      You **have been proggng**  
He/She/It **has been proggng**      They **have been proggng**

### **Prog in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                      Plural**

I **proggd**                      We **proggd**  
You **proggd**                  You **proggd**  
He/She/It **proggd**      They **proggd**

### **Prog in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was propping                      We were propping  
You were propping                You were propping  
He/She/It was propping        They were propping

**Prog in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had propped                      We had propped  
You had propped                    You had propped  
He/She/It had propped        They had propped

**Prog in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been propping                We had been propping  
You had been propping              You had been propping  
He/She/It had been propping      They had been propping

**Prog in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

I will prog                          We will prog  
You will prog                        You will prog  
He/She/It will prog                They will prog

**Prog in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be propping                    We will be propping  
You will be propping                You will be propping  
He/She/It will be propping        They will be propping

**Prog in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have progged**

**We will have progged**

**You will have progged**

**You will have progged**

**He/She/It will have progged**

**They will have progged**

**I will have been proggng**

**We will have been proggng**

**You will have been proggng**

**You will have been proggng**

**He/She/It will have been proggng**

**They will have been proggng**
