I am progging We are progging
You are progging You are progging
He/She/It is progging They are progging

Prog in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have progged We have progged

You have progged You have progged

He/She/It has progged They have progged

Prog in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been progging We have been progging

You have been progging You have been progging

He/She/It has been progging They have been progging

Prog in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Prog in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was progging We were progging
You were progging You were progging
He/She/It was progging They were progging

Prog in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had progged We had progged
You had progged You had progged
He/She/It had progged They had progged

Prog in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been progging We had been progging
You had been progging You had been progging
He/She/It had been progging They had been progging

Prog in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will prog We will prog

You will prog
You will prog

He/She/It will prog They will prog

Prog in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be progging
You will be progging
He/She/It will be progging
They will be progging

Prog in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have progged We will have progged
You will have progged You will have progged
He/She/It will have progged They will have progged

Prog in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

I will have been progging
You will have been progging
You will have been progging
He/She/It will have been progging
They will have been progging
