## Associations of "Programmed" (30 Words)

<b>broadcast</b>	Broadcast over the airwaves as in radio or television. <i>The second method is to <b>broadcast</b> the seeds together with not more than 1 kg to the acre of rapeseed.</i>
<a href="#"><u>convent</u></a>	A school attached to and run by a convent. <i>Maria entered the <b>convent</b> at the age of eighteen.</i>
<b>curriculum</b>	An integrated course of academic studies. <i>Course components of the school <b>curriculum</b>.</i>
<b>database</b>	A structured set of data held in a computer, especially one that is accessible in various ways. <i>A <b>database</b> covering nine million workers.</i>
<b>demonstrative</b>	A demonstrative determiner or pronoun. <i>An affectionate and <b>demonstrative</b> family.</i>
<b>didactic</b>	Intended to teach, particularly in having moral instruction as an ulterior motive. <i>A <b>didactic</b> novel that set out to expose social injustice.</i>
<b>educational</b>	Relating to the process of education. <i>Seeing an analyst was a very <b>educational</b> experience.</i>
<b>ergonomics</b>	The branch of engineering science in which biological science is used to study the relation between workers and their environments.
<b>expository</b>	Serving to expound or set forth. <i>Clean <b>expository</b> writing.</i>
<b>extracurricular</b>	Outside the normal routine, especially that provided by a job or marriage. <i>Sports and drama are popular <b>extracurricular</b> activities.</i>
<b>hortative</b>	Giving strong encouragement.
<b>hospice</b>	A program of medical and emotional care for the terminally ill. <i><b>Hospice</b> workers.</i>

<b>indoor</b>	Relating to sports played indoors. <i>The national <b>indoor</b> champion.</i>
<b><u>induction</u></b>	The action or process of inducting someone to a post or organization. <i>The <b>induction</b> of malformations by radiation.</i>
<b>informative</b>	Providing or conveying information. <i>A thought provoking <b>informative</b> article.</i>
<b>instructive</b>	Useful and informative. <i>It is <b>instructive</b> to compare the two projects.</i>
<b><u>internal</u></b>	Of the inner nature of a thing; intrinsic. <i>The nation s <b>internal</b> politics.</i>
<b>interpretive</b>	That provides interpretation.
<b>intramural</b>	Situated or done within the walls of a building. <i>Most of the students participated actively in the college s <b>intramural</b> sports program.</i>
<b>kindergarten</b>	A preschool for children age 4 to 6 to prepare them for primary school.
<b>moralize</b>	Comment on issues of right and wrong, typically with an unfounded air of superiority. <i>The solution to climate change is not to <b>moralize</b> from on high.</i>
<b>mural</b>	Relating to or occurring in the wall of a body cavity or blood vessel. <i><b>Mural</b> thrombosis.</i>
<b>orphanage</b>	The condition of being a child without living parents. <i>His early <b>orphanage</b> shaped his character as an adult.</i>
<b>reformatory</b>	Tending or intended to produce reform. <i><b>Reformatory</b> punishment.</i>
<b>rehabilitation</b>	The action of restoring someone to health or normal life through training and therapy after imprisonment, addiction, or illness. <i>The <b>rehabilitation</b> of the mangrove forests.</i>
<b>renewal</b>	The replacement or repair of something. <i>The contracts came up for <b>renewal</b>.</i>
<b>spreadsheet</b>	A computer program used to create and manipulate spreadsheets. <i>We have a colour coded Excel <b>spreadsheet</b> of all of our trip expenses.</i>
<b>syllabus</b>	The subjects in a course of study or teaching. <i>The history <b>syllabus</b>.</i>
<b>viewer</b>	A person who looks at or inspects something. <i>Our presenters are role models for young <b>viewers</b>.</i>
