- Intellectually productive.
- (of a sports player) high-scoring.
- Bearing in abundance especially offspring.
- (of a plant, animal, or person) producing much fruit or foliage or many offspring.

bountiful	Producing in abundance. Bountiful compliments.
considerable	Notably large in size, amount, or extent. Spent a considerable amount of time on the problem.

fecund	Intellectually productive. A lush and fecund garden.

generous	More than adequate. A generous assessment of his work.
inexhaustible	Incapable of being entirely consumed or used up. <i>His inexhaustible energy</i> .
<u>inventive</u>	Having the ability to create or design new things or to think originally. <i>Inventive ceramics.</i>
<u>lavish</u>	Sumptuously rich, elaborate, or luxurious. The critics were lavish in their praise.
<u>lush</u>	Tender and full of juice. <i>Lush</i> greenery and cultivated fields.
luxuriant	Produced or growing in extreme abundance. She tossed her luxuriant dark hair.
munificent	Characterized by or displaying great generosity. His father gave him a half dollar and his mother a quarter and he thought them munificent .
plentiful	Existing in great number or quantity. Food is plentiful .
productive	Producing or able to produce large amounts of goods, crops, or other commodities. <i>Many suffixes are common and productive</i> .
<u>profuse</u>	(of a person) extravagant. They are profuse in hospitality.
rich	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. A rich tenor voice.

superabundant Most excessively abundant.

abundant	Having plenty of. The riverbanks were abundant in beautiful wild plants.
acid	Containing acid or having the properties of an acid having a pH of less than 7. <i>The magma may start off fairly basic and end up at the close of the eruption much more</i> acid .
<u>affluent</u>	An affluent person a person who is financially well off. The affluent societies of the western world.
arable	Concerned with growing arable crops. <i>Open arable fields.</i>
<u>biodiversity</u>	The diversity of plant and animal life in a particular habitat (or in the world as a whole. A high level of biodiversity is desirable.
birthrate	The ratio of live births in an area to the population of that area; expressed per 1000 population per year.
bough	A main branch of a tree. Apple bough s laden with blossom.
create	Create or manufacture a man made product. <i>Create</i> a furor.
dysgenic	Exerting a detrimental effect on later generations through the inheritance of undesirable characteristics. <i>Dysgenic</i> breeding.
<u>factory</u>	An establishment for traders carrying on business in a foreign country. <i>The group have become a rock and roll hit factory.</i>
fecund	Producing or capable of producing an abundance of offspring or new growth; highly fertile. A fecund imagination.
fecundation	Making fertile as by applying fertilizer or manure.
fecundity	The intellectual productivity of a creative imagination. <i>Age related decline in female fecundity.</i>
<u>fertile</u>	(of soil or land) producing or capable of producing abundant vegetation or crops. <i>The fertile</i> coastal plain.



fertility	The property of producing abundantly and sustaining vigorous and luxuriant growth. Improve the soil fertility by adding compost.
fructify	Make productive or fruitful. They were sacrificed in order that their blood might fructify the crops.
<u>fruitful</u>	Producing good or helpful results; productive. <i>Be</i> fruitful <i>and multiply.</i>
harvest	Gather a crop as a harvest. The quantity of squid harvest ed has risen.
hinterland	The area around or beyond a major town or port. A market town serving its rich agricultural hinterland .
<u>lucrative</u>	Producing a great deal of profit. A lucrative career as a stand up comedian.
make	Make by shaping or bringing together constituents. Anyone can make a mistake.
produce	Show or provide (something) for consideration, inspection, or use. The vineyards in the Val d Or produce excellent wines.
productive	Producing or able to produce large amounts of goods, crops, or other commodities. Productive farmland.
<u>profitable</u>	(of a business or activity) yielding profit or financial gain. <i>The investments were extremely</i> profitable .
reproductive	Producing new life or offspring. The female reproductive system.
rich	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. A rich vein of copper.
richness	A strong deep vividness of hue. All are amazed at the richness of the colours.
topsoil	The top layer of soil. Dry topsoil s are typical in the western Corn Belt.
<u>virility</u>	The masculine property of being capable of copulation and procreation. <i>Great importance is placed on a man s virility</i> .
wealth	The quality of profuse abundance. <i>He used his considerable wealth to bribe officials.</i>
