## **Proll in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>proll</b>	We <b>proll</b>
You <b>proll</b>	You <b>proll</b>
He/She/It <b>prolls</b>	They <b>proll</b>

## **Proll in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am prolling	We <b>are prolling</b>
You <b>are prolling</b>	You <b>are prolling</b>
He/She/It is prolling	They are prolling

#### **Proll in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have prolled	We have prolled
You have prolled	You have prolled
He/She/It has prolled	They have prolled

#### **Proll in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been prolling	We have been prolling
You <b>have been prolling</b>	You have been prolling
He/She/It has been prolling	They have been prolling

## **Proll in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I prolled	We <b>prolled</b>
You <b>prolled</b>	You <b>prolled</b>
He/She/It <b>prolled</b>	They <b>prolled</b>

## **Proll in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was prolling	We were prolling
You <b>were prolling</b>	You were prolling
He/She/It was prolling	They were prolling

#### **Proll in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had prolled	We had prolled
You had prolled	You had prolled
He/She/It had prolled	They had prolled

#### **Proll in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been prolling	We had been prolling
You <b>had been prolling</b>	You had been prolling
He/She/It had been prolling	They had been prolling

## **Proll in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will proll	We will proll
You <b>will proll</b>	You <b>will proll</b>
He/She/It will proll	They will proll

## **Proll in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be prolling	We will be prolling
You <b>will be prolling</b>	You will be prolling
He/She/It will be prolling	They will be prolling
