Past Tense	prologized
Present Participle	prologizing
Past Participle	prologized

I **prologize**
You **prologize**
He/She/It **prologizes** They **prologize**

Prologize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am prologizing**
You **are prologizing**
He/She/It **is prologizing** They **are prologizing**

Prologize in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have prologized**
You **have prologized**
He/She/It **has prologized** They **have prologized**

Prologize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

I **have been prologizing**
You **have been prologizing**
He/She/It **has been prologizing** They **have been prologizing**

Prologize in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I **prologized**
You **prologized**
He/She/It **prologized** They **prologized**

Prologize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was prologizing We were prologizing
You were prologizing You were prologizing
He/She/It was prologizing They were prologizing

Prologize in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had prologized We had prologized
You had prologized You had prologized
He/She/It had prologized They had prologized

Prologize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been prologizing We had been prologizing
You had been prologizing You had been prologizing
He/She/It had been prologizing They had been prologizing

Prologize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will prologize We will prologize
You will prologize You will prologize
He/She/It will prologize They will prologize

Prologize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be prologizing We will be prologizing
You will be prologizing You will be prologizing
He/She/It will be prologizing They will be prologizing

Prologize in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have prologized

We will have prologized

You will have prologized

You will have prologized

He/She/It will have prologized **They will have prologized**

Prologize in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been prologizing

We will have been prologizing

You will have been prologizing

You will have been prologizing

He/She/It will have been prologizing **They will have been prologizing**
